 Fore part strong S.E. breeze steering N.W. with
 cloudy weather middle part squally latter part
 light breeze Long by Chron 84° 35' W Lat by Obs 20° 05' S

Remarks Tuesday June 3rd
 Fore part light breeze from the Eastward steering
 N.W. we saw some new Main topsail Braces
 middle & latter parts calm N.E. Obs

Remarks Wednesday June 4th
 Fore part light air & calms middle & latter
 parts the same Long 77° 40' W Lat by Obs 20° 05' S

Remarks Thursday June 5th
 Fore part calm brook out for water & employed
 overhauling & cleaning the Mainmast
 middle & latter parts the same

Remarks Friday June 6th
 Fore part light air from the Westward heave
 to the S.W. Westward middle part rain squalls
 the wind hauling round to the S.E. latter
 part fine breeze from S.E. steering N by E
 Long by Chron 84° 21' W Lat by Obs 19° 54' S

Remarks Saturday June 7th
 Fore part fine breeze from E.S.E. steering
 N.W. with good weather employed washing
 ship inside &c middle & latter parts
 fine breeze at 8 A.M. raised two sails spoke
 the Ripper of New London Capt Morgan, & later
 since being Calahuanos heaved to the line
 heading to the Southward
 Lat by Obs 20° 05' S

Cruising on the Archer Ground
 Remarks Sunday June 8th 1862
 Fore part strong breeze at sundown took in sail
 heading to the Southward middle & latter part
 strong breeze Long by Chron 89° 32' W Lat by Obs 20° 23' S

Remarks Monday June 9th
 Fore part strong breeze from E.S.E. steering N.W. at dark
 heaved to the wind on the Northern tack saw plenty of
 Finbacks middle & latter parts moderate a number
 of ships in sight

Remarks Tuesday June 10th
 Fore part light variable wind at 4 P.M. had a gam
 with the Sapho taken 100 lbs sperm since being
 Calahuanos spoke the Louisiana at dark middle
 & latter parts calm N.E. Obs

Remarks Wednesday June 11th
 Fore part light variable wind spoke the Oak Leaf
 nothing since being past 5 or 6 ships in sight
 middle & latter parts calm put up some new
 Main Royal Rigging
 Long by Chron 91° 04' W Lat by Obs 19° 20' S

Remarks Thursday June 12th
 Fore part calm brook out for water middle
 part took a light breeze from the S.E. at 11 P.M. had
 a total Eclipse of the moon had some rain
 squally latter part fine breeze heading to
 the S.W.

Remarks Friday June 13th
 Fore part fine breeze from E.S. heading to the
 Southward 6 ships in sight at dark took
 in sail & won ship to the S.E. middle
 & latter parts strong breeze heading to the
 N.E. saw Finbacks
