 sail & wore Ship to the NE Middle & Latter
 parts strong double reefed top sail breeze

Fore part strong breeze heading to the SE
 Middle & Latter parts the same

Remarks Taura June 20th

Fore part moderate breeze from E heading

 Calashuano Middle part the wind heading
 round to the W Latter part strong breeze saw
 some B Fish & 6 Ships

Lat 19th 44 S

Remarks Tatura June 21st

Fore part squally with rain heading to the SE
 the wind from SE & W passed the E & C Cowell's Boiling
 at dark heading E Middle & Latter parts
 much the same & Ships in sight

Remarks Taura June 22nd

Fore part moderate plenty of Ships in sight
 steering in all directions Middle & Latter parts
 much the same spoke the John Cogshall

Remarks Mond June 23rd

Fore part fine breeze from E steering NW by W
 at dark took in sail heading N Middle part
 the wind variable with rain squally Latter part
 moderate with fine weather steering E W
 employed repairing the main sail &c

Long by Chron 91st 30 W Lat by Obs 19th 09 S

Remarks Taura June 24th

Fore part light breeze from SE steering S W
 employed repairing the main sail at dark
 took in sail heading S by W Middle
 & Latter parts much the same finished bent
 the M Sail Long by Chron 92nd W Lat by Obs 19th 57 S
