Remarks *Monica* June 25th 1862

From past fresh breeze at ESE, heading to the SE
at 5 PM spoke the *Anaconda* Capt. Tamm nothing
this cruise. *Mica* part heading to the S
Latter part heading to the NE 3 Ships in sight
employed making Spungum. *Tamm* the *Chavez* &c
Lat by Obs 19° 29' S

Remarks *Thursa* June 26th

From past fine weather & moderate breeze from
the Eastward heading to the Southward
employed making Spungum &c at dusk took
in sail. *Mica* & latter part moderate
Long by Chron 91° 57' W Lat by Obs 18° 37' S

Remarks *Frída* June 27th

From past light winds & variable at 3 PM saw
Black Fish Inshore & chased without success
Mica part the wind from S heading
to the Southward. Latter part blowing on
strong double reefed the Top sails at 10 AM
Long by Chron 91° 36' W Lat by Obs 19° 18' S

Remarks *Saturday* June 28th

From past strong gales from S, SE, heading
to the E at dusk bore ship to the S W
Mica part blowing on took in the Top sail
& close reefed the Main. Lat by Obs 19° 25' S

Remarks *Sunda* June 29th

From past the gale continued heading to the
Southward. *Mica* part rather moderating
at 12 bore ship to the E & latter part
set the Main sail & bore Top sail
Long by Chron 92° 37' W Lat by Obs 19° 30' S

Cruising on the *Archer* *Cronos*

Remarks *Monica* June 30th 1862

From past strong double reefed Top sail breeze
from SE heading E NE *Mica* & latter
part much the same 3 Ships in sight
Long by Chron 92° 28' W Lat by Obs 19° 06' S

Remarks *Tuesda* July 1st

From past strong gales from ESE heading to the
Southward with heavy squalls at 6 PM took in the
Main sail heading SE by E the wind NE by E
Mica & latter part much the same
Lat by Obs 19° 46' S

Remarks *Wenesda* July 2nd

From past strong gales from the Eastward head
to the NE *Mica* part the same. Latter part
moderating set the Main sail & took
Long by Chron 92° 22' W Lat by Obs 18° 54' S

Remarks *Thursda* July 3rd

From past strong gales from the Eastward
heading S by E, at dusk shortened sail
Mica & latter part more moderate
Long by Chron 92° 35' W Lat by Obs 19° 20' S

Remarks *Frída* July 4th

From past moderate breeze heading on the
Southward took spoke the *Ben Cummings* Capt
Briggs nothing this cruise. *Mica* & latter
part light variable winds with cloudy weather
started a Cask of *Boya* 18 bags. No Obs

Remarks *Saturday* July 5th

From past light variable winds with cloudy weather
3 Ships in sight at night took in sail. *Mica*
& latter part the same with frequent rain
squalls. No Obs
