

Back Matton Vears of Dartmouth Capt Howland

Remarks Sature July 26th 1862

Fore part strong traces from E & E heading to the S finishing the main light sail & bent it at dark took in sail Midace part the same latter part steering N

Long by Chron 106° 54' W Lat by Obs 41° 33' S

Remarks Sune July 27th

Fore part fresh traces from E & E steering N saw a school of B Fish going quick to windward at dark shortened sail & heaved to on the N Eastward. Lacks Midace & latter parts the same at 11 1/2 AM spoke the Louisiana Capt Kelley 60 Mts since leaving Tahiti

Long by Chron 107° 23' W Lat by Obs 41° 24' S

Remarks Mone July 28th

Fore part strong traces heading to the S carried away one of the Backroaps Midace part strong breeze with rain squalls employed breaking out for meat water Brandy & filling some casks with salt water the latter part heading N E by E

Long by Chron 107° 45' W Lat by Obs 41° 55' S

Remarks Saise July 29th

Fore part strong traces heading to the N Eastward employed fitting some Backroaps for the Martingail & Midace & latter parts much the same fitted & put out the Backroaps & set them up

Remarks Mone July 30th

Fore part strong traces heading S E W employed making N to port rotation in at dark tacked to the S E, Midace part the same latter part breezing on tacked to the Southward took in the light sails

Long by Chron 108° 13' W Lat by Obs 41° 16' S

Cruising on the Off Shore Channel

Remarks Thurs July 31st 1862

Fore part strong traces from E & E heading to the Southward at dark single reefed the G Sticks Midace & latter parts much the same

Long by Chron 108° 24' W Lat by Obs 61° 08' S

Remarks Frid Aug 1st

Fore part strong breeze steering by the wine on South Lacks Midace & latter parts the same

Long by Chron 107° 38' W Lat by Obs 51° 31' S

Remarks Sature Aug 2nd

Fore part strong breeze from E heading N N E saw a sail at 4 P M on the he quarter Midace & latter parts much the same employed at ship duty Long by Chron 107° 39' W Lat by Obs 51° 22' S

Remarks Sune Aug 3rd

Fore part strong breeze from E by S heading S by E & saw nothing Midace & latter parts the same saw nothing but squid

Long by Chron 107° 21' W Lat by Obs 51° 08' S

Remarks Mone Aug 4th

Fore part strong traces from N E heading E N E caught a Dolphin struck another & lost him Midace & latter parts much the same employed breaking out for water filled the casks with salt water Long by Chron 107° 06' W Lat 51° 02' S

Remarks Saise Aug 5th

Fore part strong traces heading S by W at dark tacked heading N E by E Midace & latter parts much the same saw some Fair Backs

Long by Chron 107° 13' W Lat by Obs 51° 11' S
