tack at dark tacked ship to the N.E. Mice &
& Litter parts much the same sent in the
jib for repairs & bent another

Remarks Frida Aug 8th

Fore part strong breeze from E.S.E. heading
N.E. employed repairing a jib Mice &
Litter parts much the same

Remarks Satua Aug 9th

Fore part strong breeze from E.S.E. heading S
saw one or two Sun Backs Mice part beginning
in took in jib & Sparker double reefed the Sails
& Litter part strong Gale with rugged weather

Remarks Suna Aug 10th

Fore part a Gale from E.S.E. heading N.E.
hooked out for water at dark took in the main sail
Mice & Litter parts much the same

Remarks Monu Aug 11th

Fore part strong breeze Mice & Litter
parts the same saw a Ship to windward
hook on for Reef & Poles

Long by Chron 10 56 04 W Lat by Obs 40 51 S

Cruising on the off Shore Ground

Remarks Tuesa Aug 12th 1862

Fore part strong breeze heading to the South
one sail in sight at dark wore ship & put a
reef in the Top sail Mice & Litter parts squa-
lly with rain saw some Sun Backs

Remarks Wassa Aug 13th

Fore part strong Gale with rain squally from S.E.
by E heading S by W one sail in sight hooked out
for a cask of Bread found it not very good it
having got beat some time Mice & Litter
parts much the same

Long by Chron 10 56 38 W Lat by Obs 50 25 S

Remarks Thursa Aug 14th

Fore part strong Gale from S.E. by E heading
N.E. by E at dark passed close to the Emma C
partly on the opposite tack Mice & Litter
parts much the same

Long by Chron Obs same

Remarks Frida Aug 15th

Fore part strong Gale continue under double
reef Top sail & course jib in heading to
the Southward at dark wore ship to the N.E. by
E Mice & Litter parts wind & weather
the same

Lat by Obs 50 06 S

Remarks Satua Aug 16th

Fore part strong Gale from S.E. by E heading
N.E. by E Mice part the same Litter part
kept her S.W. hooked out for water & started a
minety of Molasses
