Remarks Tued Sept 16th 1862

Fore part a fresh breeze from E heading N, N E,
employed breaking out cooping & stowing down the
Lumbar in the main hold. Latter side
Midace & latter parts heading N E by E
employed stowing down Lat by Ob 4th 17 S

Remarks Wednesday Sept 17th

Fore part fresh breeze from E by E heading
N E by E employed stowing down saw nothing
but yellowed Tails caught a lot of them Midace
& latter parts much the same got the Oil
all down at noon Long by Chron 117th 03 W Lat by Ob 3th 25 S

Remarks Thursday Sept 18th

Fore part strong breeze from E & E heading
heading employed stowing down Bread
Flour meat & started two simities 1 of Beef &
one of Pork put some in the Turnery Cask &
the remainder in Blz got through stowing
at 8 P.M. & washed off stowed down 8 P.M.
besides 4 Blz Tallow Oil at 8 P.M. set the
Main Sail Midace part split the 3rd Sails
Latter part breaking out for Tails got out a 3rd Sails
Main & Mizzen Topmast Stay Sails bent a
3rd Sails Long by Chron 117th W Lat by Ob

Remarks Friday Sept 19th

Fore part strong breeze from E heading to the
N N E Midace & latter parts the same bent
a new Mizzen Topmast Stay Sail & putting
some new Tack Ropes on the Main Top Sail
Long by Chron 117th 22 W Lat by Ob 3th 22 S

Cruising on the off shore Ground

Remarks Satua Sept 20th 1862

Fore part strong breeze from E heading S, S E,
employed repairing a Main Top Sail & saw
nothing Midace & latter parts blowing stronger
Long by Chron 117th 29 W Lat by Ob 4th 39 S

Remarks Suna Sept 21st

Fore part strong breeze from E by E heading Ship
heading N E by N at 7 P.M. heading N, N E,
Midace & latter parts more moderate
Long by Chron 116th 20 W Lat by Ob 6th 05 S

Remarks Monu Sept 22nd

Fore part moderate breeze from E & E heading
N E Midace & latter parts the same bent a
new Main Topmast Stay Sail sent down the Gaff
Top Sail for repairs Long by Chron 113th 28 W Lat 4th 34 S

Remarks Tuesa Sept 23rd

Fore part moderate breeze & fine weather from E & E,
heading N E furnished the Gaff Top Sail &
bent it started a Cask of water into the Suttle
But Midace & latter parts moderate employed
repairing a Main Top Sail saw nothing tactics
Ship heading E Long by Chron 114th 46 W Lat by Ob 3th 38 S

Remarks Wednesa Sept 24th

Fore part moderate breeze from E & E heading
& furnished the 3rd Sail & bent it after 4 P.M.
had some rain squalls Midace & latter parts
continue moderate took out a Cask of Porcell
Long by Chron 113th 05 W Lat by Ob 4th 29 S
