

Barke Mattona Clear of Dartmouth Capt Rowland
Remarks Mon Nov 3rd 1862

For part noon Mate Mianee & latter party the same 3 Boats went into the River after water employed on board starting water breaking out for Breaux he took the Ideas out of four Pipes of Breaux found it all spoilt full of Bugs & worms

Remarks Tues Nov 4th

For part noon Mate 3 Boats in watering break out some Oil Soap for the Charles & Edward 3 Keggs got another raft ready to go ashore got the raft off at 3 1/2 P.M. took it in got dinner stored 30 lbs in the After Hold he Mianee put the same received 49 Cunnephins on board latter part all hands employed breaking out for Breaux storing down water took on board 10 Cords of wood

Remarks Wednes Nov 5th

For part noon Mate carried the Cooper ashore sick to the doctor employed storing down water &

Remarks Thurs Nov 6th

For part noon Mate finished storing water got another raft ready latter part two Boats went in with another raft for water took a Boat load of Potatoes on board 12 lbs got off the raft of water at 6 P.M.

Remarks Fri Nov 7th

For part discharge 6 bbls Slush & Boxes Soap & a lot of Clothing employed getting ready for painting after dinner went to painting Mr Ransome went ashore with the Capt to get his exchange by mutual consent

Laying at Cumber

Remarks Sat Nov 8th 1862

For part noon some rain the Starboard watch went ashore on liberty after Breakfast received at lot of Broom Stuff from Ole John Oysters the watch employed stripping it Painting &c received 9 bbls from shore delivered to the same man 20 lbs Slush 75 lbs Cork 10 Blankets 2 mats 1 pair pants 4 pair Socks two pair Drawers bought two bbls Oysters

Remarks Sun Nov 9th

For part fine painted the Breaux again on the Larboard side varnished the 3rd Booms &c at 12 o'clock the Starboard watch came off from liberty the Larboard watch got ready & went ashore the other watch getting ready for painting the Ship

Remarks Mon Nov 10th

For part fine the Larboard watch went ashore on liberty

Remarks Tues Nov 11th

For part fine the Larboard watch ashore on liberty the watch on board employed Painting &c

Remarks Wednes Nov 11th

For part fine the Larboard watch came off from liberty with a man shipped her as third Officer Namee Atwood got a small raft ready & sent it ashore stored down water &c

Remarks Thurs Nov 12th

For part fine got off a raft of water stored it down & got the Ship ready for sea two Boats went into the River for Sana & Bone Poles &c
