

Bark Matilda Coast of Dartmouth Capt Howland
Remarks Sunda Nov 14th 1862

Fore part fine weather midday & latter part the same the Boat went in for the Captain the Whip all ready for sea the Capt came aboard at 12 o'clock

Remarks Sunda Nov 15th

Fore part fresh breeze & heavy rain weather at dusk for the time to pass when it set in thick & windy gave up getting under weigh till morning latter part moderate breeze all hands at daylight & have shot at 7 AM took our Anchor & stood to sea with a light breeze from the Westward

Remarks Sunda Nov 16th

Fore part light breeze from the Westward heading to the S. S. W. at 6 AM taken off shore heading N. N. W. the Sunda dist 3 miles midday part the wind backing up latter part strong breeze Cape Blanco in sight

Remarks Sunda Nov 17th

Fore part strong breeze from S. W. working up the coast for Paita at sundown we were abreast of Cape Blanco dist 4 miles one ship in sight midday & latter part much the same at 12 o'clock about 10 miles to leeward of Point Negro

Lat by Obs 4° 24' S

Remarks Sunda Nov 18th

Fore part strong breeze from S. W. working up the coast at 6 AM Point Negro bore E. S. E. dist 3/4 of a mile at 6 PM light breeze taken to the W. in 10 fathoms water two ships in sight midday & latter part moderate at 11 AM took a breeze so we could lay for Paita

Bona off Shore

Remarks Manisa Nov 19th 1862

Fore part fresh breeze steering for Paita at 2 PM got into the Anchorage when the Capt went on shore the Boat came off at sundown with letters the Capt stopped on shore the ship stood off midday part moderate Sunda part the same at 12 o'clock sent the Boat in the ship off the town at 2 PM the Boat came off with a lot of Onions & a Bag of Irish Potatoes

Remarks Sunda Nov 20th

Fore part strong breeze got off our Onions at 6 PM the Capt came off when we were forward & stood to sea heading N. by E midday part moderating latter part moderate with windy weather stowed the Anchors & Chains

Remarks Sunda Nov 21st

Fore part moderate breeze from the S steering W. got in an old Boat we used in port & put out the Mast Boat took out for Iron Hoops & Manilla & latter part moderate employed repairing the old Boat painting the Mast Boat &c Lat by Obs 4° 28' S Long by Chron 84° 20'

Remarks Sunda Nov 22nd

Fore part moderate breeze from S. E steering N. W. employed at ship's duty saw a school of 12 fish this morning midday & latter part light winds at 10 AM saw a school of Cory & Calves at 11 PM saw a school of Black Fish got among them & started them to leeward Lat by Account 2° 40' S

Remarks Sunda Nov 23rd

Fore part light breeze got to leeward of the whaling when they missed off to leeward the Boat struck one the whaling started to leeward two or three stopped round the first when a few minutes the Boat struck a calf & away the Boat went on & didn't get fast got the Whaler long way at 5 PM & got ready for cutting started a Blk of Boat
