For part a moderate breeze from E & E heading
to the S two ships in sight at 7 A.M. spoke
the *Mary* & *Susan* Capt Howland 3000 out
14 or 15 belonging to New Bedford
mice & latter parts continue moderate
Lat by Ch 4135 S

Remarks Mone Jan 4th

For part fine breeze at 8 A.M. heading to the S some
sails in sight the man that came out from home
with us as steward gave up his billet & moved out
of the Cabin into the Stowage by mutual agreement
he is to stow mast heads & make himself generally
usefull took a man from forward to act in his place
as Steward Name Timothy Grant the de Steward
was better calculated for some other billet than Steward
Mice & latter parts moderate breeze the Fair

Remarks Tusa Jan 5th

For part fine breeze steering to the S two ships in
sight at 6 A.M. spoke the *Ross* Capt Macomber two whales
this season Mice part heading to the Southward
low ship at daylight employed repairing the
main sail Long by Chron 107.53 W Lat by Ch 4157 S

Remarks Tusa Jan 6th

For part nice breeze with fine weather the ship
on the S Eastern back finished repairing
the main sail & sent it at 4 P.M. at 6 P.M.
had a rain squall Mice & latter parts
the same

Cruising on the Off Shore
Remarks Tusa Jan 8th 1863

For part fresh breeze the ship heading to the S
Mice & latter parts strong breeze pointed the
Starboard Boat

Remarks Tusa Jan 9th

For part strong breeze heading NE by E by 8 P.M. little
muggy weather saw nothing Mice & latter parts
the same Long by Chron 108.01 W Lat by Ch 5117 S

Remarks Tusa Jan 10th

Remarks strong breeze from SE at 5 P.M. spoke the
Anacora 2000 out 500 two whales this season Mice
& latter parts squally Long by Chron 107.44 W Lat by Ch 5109 S

Remarks Tusa Jan 11th

For part squally heading E & SE saw nothing
Mice part the same at 8 A.M. saw 3 fish
brought two one to the Mast & one to the L Boat
one ship in sight got them about at 10 A.M. Ch

Remarks Mone Jan 12th

For part fresh breeze heading to the S & W Mice
the 3 fish & cleared up deck Mice part squally
latter part more moderate employed running
muzzing & boiling 12 fish blubber
Long by Chron 107.29 W Lat by Ch 5107 S

Remarks Tusa Jan 13th

For part fresh breeze from E & E heading N & W Mice
boiling muzzed up 5 lbs two sails in sight at 6 P.M.
took in the light sails & shifted to the main
heading NE by E by 8 P.M. started some fish & pork
Mice & latter parts the same employed hauling
the barrels to the cruet of the fore yard spoke
the Active
