Remarks Tuesday Feb 17th 1863

Fore part light S.E. breeze heading E by N and down
 the main top sails upwind & bent it again at 4 P.M.
 Mice & latter parts continue moderate employe
 Kitting down the Mizzin Rigging No Obz

Remarks Monday Feb 18th

Fore part moderate fine weather employe shorten
 the Backsails & the ship heading to the Southward
 Mice & latter parts the same breakout must

Long by Chron 111° 13' W Lat by Obz 3° 33' S

Remarks Thursday Feb 19th

Fore part fine weather & moderate breeze from S.E. by E
 heading S by W, employe at ship's duty Mice
 part the same at daylight got a Tackle up over
 the Fore Hatch for breaking out Oil to Cooper latter
 part all hands employe No Obz

Remarks Friday Feb 20th

Fore part fine breeze from S.E. heading to the
 N.E. all hands employe taking out
 Coopering & stowing down Oil Mice &
 latter parts the same Lat by Obz 4° 44' S

Remarks Saturday Feb 21st

Fore part fresh breeze heading to the S finish
 the Oil in the Fore Hold & stow off finished
 at 4 P.M. washed off after supper made all sail
 Mice part much the same latter part squally
 with rain Long 111° 35' W Lat by Obz 6° 29' S

Heading to the Southward

Remarks Sunday Feb 22nd 1863

Fore part squally with rain the ship heading
 from S by W to S by E but held this afternoon from
 the first time Mice & latter parts strong
 Long by Chron 112° 28' W Lat by Obz 8° 45' S

Remarks Monday Feb 23rd

Fore part strong breeze heading S by W with cloudy
 weather Mice & latter parts much the same
 have some new Fore & Main Ropes put on
 Downhaul &c Long by Chron 113° 07' W Lat by Obz 11° 17' S

Remarks Tuesday Feb 24th

Fore part moderate winds from E.S.E. heading S
 employe shorting the Viding & Capping the
 Fore Rigging Mice & latter parts squally
 Lat by Obz 13° 28' S

Remarks Wednesday Feb 25th

Fore part storm clouds from S.E. to E.S.E. with frequent
 rain squalls employe at ship's duty Mice
 & latter parts the same Lat by Obz 15° 37' S

Remarks Thursday Feb 26th

Fore part strong squally clouds well to the E head
 from S.E. to S split the M. top Mast Sail and it
 down upwind & bent it again Mice &
 latter parts the same Lat by Obz 18° 05' S

Remarks Friday Feb 27th

Fore part the winds baffling & squally with
 rain Mice & latter parts the same
 employe at ship's duty No Obz
