 Long 99° 20' W Lat 33° 03' S

Remarks Saturday Mar 14th
 For part moderate breeze from S. E. heading E. N. E.
 & N. E. by E. P. M. with some rain squalls. Middle &
 Latter parts variable winds with rain squalls
 heading from N. to E. N. E. Lat 34° 13' South

Remarks Sunday Mar 15th
 For part light winds & variable heading from
 N. to E. N. E. broke a Bl. of Surf but held. Middle
 & Latter parts much the same
 Long 96° 30' W Lat 33° 34' S

Remarks Monday Mar 16th
 For part moderate breeze from the Eastward
 heading from N. E. to N. N. E. at 4 P. M. saw a large
 double Top Sail Ship standing to the Northward
 at 6 P. M. we tackied heading S. E. E. Middle
 & Latter parts the same Lat 33° 40' S
 Long 95° 53' W

 For part light variable winds tackied Ship at
 6 P. M. heading S. E. by S. Middle part the same
 Latter part calm Long 94° 55' W Lat 34° 10' S

Remarks Wednesday Mar 18th
 For part calm started a Bl. of Surf at 12 P. M.
 took a light breeze from S. W. steering E. at daylight
 the fine S. W. Latter part the same employed
 repairing an old Boat. Long 94° 10' W Lat 34° 20' S

Remarks Thursday Mar 19th
 For part light air from S. W. steering E. employed
 at Ship's duty. Middle part variable winds. Latter part
 variable winds & calms with rain hook out for water
 N. O. B.

Remarks Friday Mar 20th
 For part light variable winds & calms heading
 all round the compass. Course E. by S. one Ship in
 sight employed washing Ship. Middle part
 took a breeze from the Southward steering E. Latter
 part fine weather painted in old Boat. X.
 Long 91° 20' W Lat 34° 16' S

Remarks Saturday Mar 21th
 For part fresh breeze from S. W. steering E. by N. S.
 Middle & Latter parts the wind more to the
 S. Long by Chron 88° 35' W Lat by Obs 34° 26' S

Remarks Sunday Mar 22nd
 For part strong breeze from S. E. steering E. N. E.
 blew two Pies but held. Middle part the
 same. Latter part the wind more to the E.
 heading N. E. Long 86° 18' W Lat 33° 35' S
