

Back Maitan Head of Dartmouth Capt. Kurlana
Remarks Thrusa April 2nd 1863

Fore part strong breeze from the S.W. heading to the
S.E. at 6 P.M. saw one point on the weather bow
at 2.5 miles bore ship to the W. Middle & latter
parts moderating

Remarks Fair April 3rd

Fore part fresh breeze from the S.E. bore ship to
the E. saw in sight on the weather bow employed
breaking out for meat sugar India apples &c. middle
part strong on latter part double reefed the top sails
Long 77° 10' W Lat 33° 0' 6" S

Remarks Calm April 4th

Fore part strong breeze from S.E. heading E & E by N
sailing on at sundown took in main sail fore sail
jib & sprit. Close reefed the top sails at the mainmast
& took up the lee brails middle & latter parts continue
much the same saw plenty of fair backs
Long by Chron 76° 02' W Lat by Obs 32° 58' S

Remarks Breeze April 5th

Fore part a hale from S.E. heading E but hold opened
a pipe of Mead Middle & latter parts the same
continued about the same
Long 75° 18' W Lat 32° 58' S

Remarks Breeze April 6th

Fore part a hale from S heading from E to E & E,
at 12 P.M. heaving on took in the fore top sail
middle & latter parts the same
Long 74° 35' W Lat 32° 45' S

Cruising to the E of the Islands
Remarks Thrusa April 7th 1863

Fore part the same rather moderating at the fore
stay sail middle part moderating latter part calm
with cloudy weather repeated the spanker 200 lbs

Remarks Breeze April 8th

Fore part light air from the S.W. steering S by W saw
plenty of hump backs middle part surging up a little
latter part moderate breeze with cloudy weather 200 lbs

Remarks Thrusa April 9th

Fore part moderate breeze from S.W. steering S by W with
cloudy weather saw plenty of Sulphur Bottoms & hump backs
at dark took in sail & huffed to the wind heading
S.W. by W middle part squally with rain latter
part strong breeze steering S.E. by E
Long 73° 56' W Lat 34° 18' S

Remarks Fair April 10th

Fore part the wind from the S.W. moderating
steering S.E. by E at 4 P.M. calm middle part light
air heading to the S.W. latter part steering E & E,
broke out for water Long 73° 37' W Lat 34° 40' S

Remarks Calm April 11th

Fore part fresh breeze at V steering E & E, at 4 P.M. saw
Luna ahead somewhere in the vicinity of Maule at
dark double reefed the top sails & bore ship heading
N.W. by W middle part moderating latter part light
breeze saw black fish larvae & got 4 took them long since
at 12
Lat 35° 00' S

Remarks Breeze April 12th

Fore part light air saw 13 fish again larvae caught
one small one came on board cleared away but hold
& washed off took in light sails at dark heading
W by S the wind to the S.W. middle & latter
parts calm the Luna in sight 3 miles off
