Remarks Tusa May 26<sup>th</sup> 1863

Fore part moanate breeze from the W by W heading to the Southward two sails in sight - have a gun with the Motta & the Brilliant-Miaule & latter parts fire saw the ship to have boiling fat 27 "10 S

Remarks Mianisa May 27<sup>th</sup>

Fore part fresh breeze from the S by W heading to the Westward at 7 P.M. heading S by W double reefed the Top Sails Miaule part low ship latter part strong double reefed Top Sails breeze heading E two ships in sight employed crewing & knotting gear

Remarks Thursday May 28<sup>th</sup>

Fore part strong Gale from S by E heading E at 6 P.M. low ship to the S by W under double reefed Top Sails, filled the M Sails Miaule & latter parts fresh breeze after breakfast saw a ship cutting spoke her at 11 A.M. the Gun shot of Fort Mifflin two whales since leaving Talcahuano this was about an 80 blt follow Long 78 "44 W lat 27 "12 S

Remarks Friday May 29<sup>th</sup>

Fore part strong winds from SE heading to NE at dawn double reefed the Top Sails filled the M Sails & low ship heading S by W made some Spinn gear today Miaule & latter parts the same started a blt of Buf.

Remarks Saturday May 30<sup>th</sup>

Fore part fresh breeze & rugga from S by E heading to the S by W at 7 P.M. spoke the President Capt Macy 10 days from Talcahuano low ship to the E latter part moanating made sail employed making gear Long 78 "33 W lat 27 "10 S

Cruising off St Felix

Remarks Tusa May 31<sup>st</sup> 1863

Fore part fresh breeze from the SE heading from E to E, N.E., two ships in sight - let Hoda & Miaule & latter parts moanate

Remarks Mianisa June 1<sup>st</sup>

Fore part light winds heading to the S by W, Miaule part the same at 7 A.M. lashed to the E started a blt of Dock repaired the Foretopmast Stay Sail & sent it & sent in the job for repairing the Account in sight

Remarks Tusa June 2<sup>nd</sup>

Fore part light winds & calm heading to the Eastward finished the job & sent it at dusk took in the light Sails Miaule part the same latter part squally with rain Long 78 "46 W lat 27 "17 S

Remarks Mianisa June 3<sup>rd</sup>

Fore part the wind variable with rain squally head to the S Westward at dusk double reefed the Top Sails & low ship to the E, S.E., the wind S, Miaule part breezing on latter part a Gale at 4 A.M. kept her off N by W Long 78 "38 W lat 26 "35 S

Remarks Thursday June 4<sup>th</sup>

Fore part strong Gale from the S.E.E. steering to the N Westward at 2 P.M. steering W by N at dusk took in the Foretop Sails close reefed the main & luffed to the W heading S by S, very rugga took out for water Miaule part blowing strong at daylight St Ambrose on the seaboard bearing W by S dist 25 miles let the Foretop Sails & kept her off N by W by W lat 26 "02 S
