Remarks Fair June 5th 1863

Fore part strong breeze from E by S steering N by W by
W at 2 P.M. St. Andrew bore S east - 40 miles
Midace & Lutter part strong breeze employed
at Ship's duty Lat 24° 25' S

Remarks Saturday June 6th

Fore part strong breeze with frequent rain squalls
from the S.E. steering N.W. by W saw a Ship steaming
to the E. took out for water Midace part the
same Lutter part the breeze light & variable
with rain squalls Lat 23° 10' S

Remarks Sunday June 7th

Fore part light breeze varying from E to S steering
W by N took out for Beef Pork & oil to burn D
ut. Hota & Midace & Lutter part the breeze from
the N.W. heading to the S & W

Remarks Monday June 8th

Fore part the breeze from the W.N.W. heading
to the S.W. at 6 P.M. took a Ship heading N.W. by N
Midace part the breeze heading round to the
Eastward steering W by N light breeze Lutter part
the same Long 84° 00' W. Lat 22° 38' S

Remarks Tuesday June 9th

Fore part moderate breeze from the S.E. steering
W by N employed at Ship's duty Midace &
Lutter part fine breeze with cloudy weather
employed repairing the Main Sail No Ob.

Remarks Wednesday June 10th

Fore part fresh breeze from the S.E. steering W by N
finished the main sail & bent it Midace & Lutter
part fresh breeze with cloudy weather No Ob.

Remarks Thursday June 11th

Fore part strong breeze from E.S.E. steering W by N
at dusk could see the Top Sails & buffed to the
wind on the Starboard tack heading N.E.
Midace part the same at 7 A.M. kept her off N.W.
strong breeze Long 87° 57' W. Lat 20° 32' South

Remarks Friday June 12th

Fore part strong breeze running to the N.W. at 4
P.M. spoke the President of New Bedford Capt. Macy
44 mms out - 12.00 Spin Midace part heading to the
Southward Lutter part steering N.W. employed
making Spin yarn & Long 88° 37' W. Lat 20° 23' S.

Remarks Saturday June 13th

Fore part strong breeze steering S.W. two Ships in sight
one was a Galle Midace & Lutter part strong breeze
with cloudy weather at 7 A.M. kept her off N.W. by
N employed making Spin yarn No Ob.

Remarks Sunday June 14th

Fore part strong breeze steering to the N.W. Midace
employed making Spin yarn ut. Hota &
at dusk took in Sail heading S by the wind
which was E.S.E. Lutter part the same steering
N Long 90° 01' W. Lat 19° 59' S
