Remarks Thursday June 25th 1863

Fore part strong amble breeze top sail hazy at 8 by 9
heading NE by N brook out a pipe of Baa Brease
for the Hogs Miacre part the same latter part
moderate fast Long 91° 57' W Lat 19° 49' S

Remarks Friday June 26th

Fore part light breeze from SE employees repairing
the main & spinnec two ships in sight at dusk
amble breeze heading S by the line very light
Miacre part the same latter part had some
rain squalls tacked to the NE brook out for Long
Island at 19.14 S Long

Remarks Saturday June 27th

Fore part light breeze from SE heading to the
E NE brook out for a new main spinnec & bent it
killed a kind of molasz miacre & latter part
moderate saw two birds to windward employees
repairing the Fore sail Long Lat 19° 14' S

Remarks Sunday June 28th

Fore part moderate breeze & fine weather heading
to the NE finished repairing the Fore sail & bent it
after sundown had a game with the Island
Miacre part hugging up latter part strong breeze
Long 92° 45' W Lat 19° 00' S

Remarks Monday June 29th

Fore part strong breeze bore ship to the E & the
line & saw nothing Miacre & latter part
the same Long Lat

Cruising on the Archer Ground

Remarks Tuesday June 30th 1863

Fore part light wind from the NE heading to the
the Eastward with rain squalls Miacre & latter
part fine saw several ships Lat 19° 00' S

Remarks Wednesday July 1st

Fore part light wind from the NNE heading to the
E spoke the Lancer & had a game Miacre part
continued fine employees fitting some
Back Ropes to the Mastangaic & Lat 20° 40' S
Long 92° 41' W

Remarks Thursday July 2nd

Fore part light breeze from the NNE heading
from E to SE employees at above at dusk look in
light sail Miacre part the line hauled more
to the E wore ship to the N, NE, then ships in sight
employees fitting some new job Penants making
sunt & Long 91° 24' W Lat 20° 14' S

Remarks Friday July 3rd

Fore part fine breeze at E heading N, NE,
employees at ship duty at dusk stationed sail
Miacre & latter part had some rain squalls
Long 91° 43' W Lat 20° 10' S

Remarks Saturday July 4th

Fore part fine breeze heading to the NE Miacre
& latter part had frequent rain squalls put out
some new Back Ropes

Remarks Sunday July 5th

Fore part fresh breeze from E, SE, heading to the
NE employees blacksmithing Sailorsing &
bat hole for a change at dusk amble breeze
Miacre & latter part much the same at 1 Am
wore ship to the SE by S Long 90° 13' W Lat 19° 34' S
