Remarks Monn July 6th 1863

Fore part fresh breeze from E & E heading to the
S & E with frequent rain squalls at dusk under reefed
at 1 A.M. breezing on both in fore & after parts
part double reefed Top Sail breeze Lat 21° 14' S

Remarks Tuesa July 7th

Fore part strong breeze from E & E ship heading
N, N.E., back out for meat & mackerel & after parts
much the same No Ob

Remarks Wednesa July 8th

Fore part strong gales from the E heading N, N.E.
employees at ship's duty mackerel & after parts
moderating with rain squalls
Long 89° 04' W Lat 19° 12' S

Remarks Thursa July 9th

Fore part strong breezes with rain squalls from the
Eastward heading from N.E. to N, N.E. employees
overhauling Black & mackerel & after parts much the
same Long Lat 17° 30' S

Remarks Frida July 10th

Fore part fresh breeze from E heading N.E. by N
with cloudy weather & some rain in squalls mackerel
& after parts much the same
Long 87° 23' W Lat 16° 35' S

Remarks Saturda July 11th

Fore part strong Trades heading to the N.E.
with squally weather mackerel & after parts
much the same
Long 86° 13' W Lat 15° 14' S

Bona to the Chincha Islands

Remarks Suna July 12th 1863

Fore part strong Trades & squally with rain heading
to the N.E. mackerel employees Blacksmithing &
opened a cask of Pork & hot food mackerel & after
parts the same Long 84° 45' W Lat 14° 01' S

Remarks Monn July 13th

Fore part breezing on double reefed the Top Sails
mackerel & after parts continue heading N.E. by E
with frequent rain squalls employees drawing &
knotting yarn & Long 82° 48' W Lat 13° 10' S

Remarks Tuesa July 14th

Fore part strong Trades at S.E. by E heading N.E. by E
mackerel could reef saw a number of Fin Backs
mackerel part the same after part moderating mackerel
& out of the Top Sails Long 82° 44' W Lat 12° 20' S

Remarks Wednesa July 15th

Fore part strong breeze from E heading E, N.E.,
with hazy weather employees at ordinary duty
mackerel & after parts much the same
Long 81° 15' W Lat 11° 36' S

Remarks Thursa July 16th

Fore part Fresh Trades heading N.E. by E employees
filling some new fish boxes & mackerel & after parts
had some rain squalls saw some Hump Backs
Long 79° 37' W Lat 11° 6' S

Remarks Frida July 17th

Fore part moderate breeze from the S.E. heading
E at 6 P.M. backed ship to the S.W. mackerel & after
parts the same saw some Hump Backs
Long 79° 53' W Lat 11° 20' S
