Remarks Sataua July 18th 1863
Fore part light breeze from the S E looking the Ship
to leeward midair & latter parts fine breeze
Long 80° 07' W Lat 11° 35' S

Remarks Sataua July 19th
Fore part fine breeze from S E heading E, N E,
let hold & c midair & latter parts much the same
No Obz.

Remarks Monea July 20th
Fore part fine breeze from S E heading E, N E,
saw some Humpbacks midair & latter parts
much the same H No Obz.

Remarks Sataua July 21st
Fore part moderate breeze from S E heading E, N E,
with downy weather saw Black Fish & some but cannot
get any back out some Bury & took finished the
Pilot Sails & set them up midair & latter parts continue
moderate Long 78° 40' W Lat 12° 08' S

Remarks Monea July 22nd
Fore part moderate breeze from S E with downy
weather heading to the Eastward employed
reaving mid Sanyard to the Fore Riggering
midair & latter parts much the same
Long 78° 22' W Lat 12° 22' S

Remarks Sataua July 23rd
Fore part fine breeze from S E looking Ship to
the E, N E, finished reaving mid Sanyard
to the Fore Riggering two Ships in sight the
Cooper sitting up Shocks midair & latter parts
much the same Long 77° 25' W Lat 12° 29' S

Bound to the Chinches
Remarks Sataua July 24th 1863

Fore part moderate breeze from S E saw Sataua on the
Le Bow, small Ship in sight at 6 P M took a Ship
heading S, E W at 5 A M took a again to the Eastward
latter part employed breaking out for water stowing
casks to put water in in the Fore & Main Holds & c
Lat 12° 37' S

Remarks Sataua July 25th
Fore part fine breeze from the S E heading to the
Eastward saw Sataua on the Le Bow 40 miles off & Ship
in sight the Cooper sitting up Shocks & c midair &
latter parts the wind light saw the Sataua ahead
employed washing Ship No Obz.

Remarks Sataua July 26th
Fore part light air heading to the E finished
washing Ship & let hold at 6 P M the Sataua west
15 miles ahead was round heading off 6 Miles in sight
midair & latter parts continue moderate
Long 75° 54' W Lat 13° 10' S

Remarks Monea July 27th
Fore part light air & calm heading in for the
Sataua on the Eastern Tack saw a small town in
abast of the Ship two vessels at anchor at 8 P M the Sataua
west 5 miles was Ship to the Westward about Calm
a number of Ships in sight midair part calm latter
part fresh breeze heading to the S E W
Lat 13° 13' S

Remarks Sataua July 28th
Fore part light breeze standing in shore the Sataua in
sight & small Ships at 6 P M nearly calm was round
heading & employed sitting up Shocks & c
midair & latter parts about calm employed breaking
out for Bury started two Cask containing 5 Bbls of
Bury the weather cloudy No Obz.
