

Bark Matilda Seas of Dartmouth Capt Howland
Remarks Mon Aug 31st 1863

Fore part moderate breeze from the Southward at 2 P.M.
the Ship 4 or 5 miles from the Tana a Boat went in fishing
Caught a few the Tisco & Gypsy in sight had a game
Micael part saying off & on after breakfast two Boats went in
after Wood got off two Coras

Remarks Tues Sept 1st

Fore part moderate one Boat went in fishing & another
after the Captain got some old Iron & 5 or 6 old Deck Planks
at dusk the Boats returned got some Fish Micael part
moderate at the People ashore had a barrel of Flour
some Staps & Molasses to pay for the Wood &c. Latter
part fine two Boats went in Fishing

Remarks Wednes Sept 2nd

Fore part moderate the Boats returned at 4 P.M.
got about 150 Fish Micael & Latter part fine
breeze from the Southward had some rain the Tana
in sight 4 Points on the Sea Bow & one Ship

Remarks Thurs Sept 3rd

Fore part light winds from the S.E. heading
to the N.E. at dusk had a game with the
Gypsy Capt Robinson Micael & Latter part
moderate at 11 A.M. kept her & the women
N.W. given in sight on the Starboard Beam
Long 78° 32' W Lat 33° 48' S

Remarks Frid Sept 4th

Fore part light breeze from the Westward steering
S Micael part the wine hauling W.S. & X
squally with rain Latter part strong breeze
one sail in sight
Long 78° 40' W Lat 33° 39' S

Borneo to Chili

Remarks Saturs Sept 5th 1863

Fore part strong breeze from S.E. heading S.E. saw
nothing Micael & Latter part heading to the Eastward
saw a Ship & some large pieces of Spica employed sitting
up the main stay &c
Lat 35° 58' S

Remarks Sun Sept 6th

Fore part strong Gale from the S.E. heading to the
N.E. at dusk at 2 P.M. could see the Top
Sails at 6 P.M. in main & fore & spanker & jib. Micael
part breezing on took in the fore Top Sail & fore Ship
to the Westward Latter part the same Lat 37° 13' S

Remarks Mon Sept 7th

Fore part a Gale from the S.E. Micael part the
same at 5 A.M. wore Ship to the E.S.E. Latter part
moderating a little at the fore Top Sail jib &
Spanker had frequent rain squalls Lat 37° 11' S
Long 77° 13' W

Remarks Tues Sept 8th

Fore part strong Gale from the S heading E.S.E.
under double reefed Top Sails Micael part moderate
Latter part better weather turned the Sails out of the Top
Sails employee breaking out for Water Molasses &c
Long 76° 12' W Lat 37° 27' S

Remarks Wednes Sept 9th

Fore part moderate breeze from the S.E. heading
to the S.E. employees breaking out for Meat &c. started
a Bbl of each the Carpenter repairing the Starboard Boat
Micael part continues moderate Latter part nearly
calm employee repairing the main sail
Long 75° 56' W Lat 37° 10' South
