Remarks Thursday Sept 10th 1863

Fore part took a light breeze from the Westward
striking S & W furnished repairing the main
sail & bent it sent down the main top gallant
sail apper it up & put part of it on the main
sail. Micae & latter parts moderate employees
repairing the fore top gallant sail

Remarks Friday Sept 11th

Fore part light breeze from S & E heading to the
S Westward saw some Black Fish going quick to
windward furnished the top gallant sail & bent
it to the main at 6 PM lashed to the Eastward
Micae part breezing on latter part strong breeze
sent down the fore top gallant yard

Remarks Saturday Sept 12th

Fore part strong breeze from the Southward heading
E by S at 4 PM double reefed the top sails & went
Ship to the S W saw a number of Fin Backs this
day Micae & latter parts much the same

Remarks Sunday Sept 13th

Fore part strong breeze from S & E heading to the
Eastward let hold & Micae & latter parts calm

Remarks Monday Sept 14th

Fore part calm Micae & latter parts the same
employees sitting up the job stays sent in the
Fl. jib & bent the main top gallant stay sail in
its place bent a new fore stay sail also

Remarks Tuesday Sept 15th 1863

Fore part took a light breeze from the S Westward heading
to the S E employees repairing a 3rd side Micae part
took a breeze from the Northward striking S latter
part fine breeze employees repairing an old boat &c
Lat 40°30' S

Remarks Wednesday Sept 16th

Fore part fine breeze from the NW at 3 PM began to
rain when the wind all died away at 5 PM the
up raining took the breeze again from the W heading
to the N with frequent rain squalls during the night
latter part fine breeze with rain squalls during I saw a
Ship standing to the W Chileano

Long 76°28' W Lat 42°05' S

Remarks Thursday Sept 17th

Fore part fresh breeze from the N steering Suman
double reefed top sail at sun down luffed to the wind
heading E, N E, Micae & latter parts fine

Long 76°24' W Lat 42°44' S

Remarks Friday Sept 18th

Fore part fine Micae part breezing up from the
NW heading to the N, N E, at daylight three sails
in sight breezing on with rain took in the jib &
main sail

N 80° E

Remarks Saturday Sept 19th

Fore part a Gale from the NW with rain bore Ship
to the S W took in the fore sail & fore top sail at
5 PM spoke the Gypsy had seen Wright Whales 3 days
in succession & got one at 6 PM downed the
fore top sail & let it plenty of rain heading S, E, W
Micae part rainy latter part a little rain in squalls
heading to the S E let hold started a Wh of Bruf & Bark
