Remarks Sunda Jan 9th 1864

Fore part fine breeze from the S.W. steering to the Eastward
the Ben Cummings in sight ahead at 3 1/2 P.M.
saw Wright Whales two of them going quick to the S.W.
downed at 5 1/2 P.M. the W Boat struck the Whale
took his line the S Boat struck the whale & ran him
up took him long side at dusk quite mugged midea
put the same cable all hands at daylight got
ready & went to cutting finisher at 12 spoke the
Ben Cummings & Whales this season started a
Bbl of Pork

Long 80° 09' W Lat 44° 32' S

Remarks Jan 10th Sunda

Fore part fresh breeze from the S.W. heading to the
Westward cleared up the Deck & started the
works the Ben went off out of sight to the E
midea & latter part fine employees boiling
& setting up Shooks

Remarks Monday Jan 11th

Fore part nearly calm midea part took a light-
breeze from the N.W. employees boiling finisher
& cooler down at 9 A.M. all hands employees
stowing down in the Fore peak & scow side
latter part fresh breeze heading to the S.W.
had some rain No Obz

Remarks Tuesday Jan 12th

Fore part strong breeze from the N.W. S.W.,
with thick rainy weather all hands employees
stowing down stowed 50 Bbls midea part thick
& rainy latter part the wind hauled to the S.E.,
& cloudy calmer all hands at 4 P.M. & commenced
stowing down again No Obz

Cruising on Chili

Remarks Weneesa Jan 13th 1864

Fore part moderate breeze from the S.E. heading
to the Eastward finisher stowing down & cleared
up Deck at 6 P.M. Ben 48 hours stowing one side
of the Fore Peak & midea took in sail midea
part the same at 7 A.M. took the ship to the S.W.
employees snapping Bone sitting up Shooks &c
Long 80° 26' W Lat 45° 06' S

Remarks Thursday Jan 14th

Fore part light breeze from the S heading to the
Westward at 3 P.M. saw a ship to leeward caught
two Porpoises spoke the ship at 7 1/2 P.M. the Fish-
Bury of N.W. Capt Shaman 40 mms out 1800.4 Whales
this season midea part moderate latter part fresh breeze
from the W.S.W. heading to the S.W.
Long W Lat 45° 25' S

Remarks Friday Jan 15th

Fore part strong breeze from the N.W. heading to the
W.S.W. at 6 P.M. came in thick took in the main sail
midea part the wind hauled to the S & cleared off
latter part fresh breeze heading to the Westward
Long 82° 35' W Lat 45° 08' S

Remarks Saturday Jan 16th

Fore part fresh breeze from the S heading to the W.S.
two ships in sight at 7 P.M. spoke the Gypsy 13 Whales
this season 1000 Bbls midea part fine latter part
the wind from the Westward steering to the E
Long 81° 49' W Lat 44° 54' S

Remarks Sunday Jan 17th

Fore part continue steering to the E at 8 P.M. had a
gale with the Ben Cummings & Gypsy fine weather
got 7 Bbls of Beef from the Gypsy midea & latter part
fine at 6 A.M. kept her off S.E.
Long Lat 45° 10' S
