Remarks *Thursa Feb 25<sup>th</sup> 1864*

From past moderate the boat got off from fishing at 7 1/2 PM the Capt. Lanning with the *Rosco* let her have 4 bbls of Potatoes in a fair calm at daylight took a breeze from the Southwester heading to the W at 10 AM a Kanak by the name of Frank said he shipped in Salcedo for one year & belonged to Oratongo sent up the Hon. Top Gallant Giza saw two ships.

Remarks *Fria Feb 26<sup>th</sup>*

From past a moderate breeze from the S heading to the S W at 6 PM breezed the Kanak took in the light sails heading S W. (Miauer & Lutter parts strong breeze (Mafafuru in sight at daylight to the Westward)

Remarks *Saturday Feb 27<sup>th</sup>*

From past strong breeze from the S heading to the Eastward at 5 1/2 PM spoke the Fish Ferry & had a gam miauer & Lutter parts strong and a rupa Top Sail breeze (Miauer)

Remarks *Sunda Feb 28<sup>th</sup>*

From past strong breeze with cloudy weather from the Southward miauer & Lutter parts the same heading to the Eastward. When in sight & one or two sails were ship to the S W.

Remarks *Mona Feb 29<sup>th</sup>*

From past strong breeze with double rupa Top Sails. Giza & Frank in miauer & Lutter parts much the same (Mafafuru in sight to the Westward)  
Lat 33° 51' S

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*Cruising off Mafafuru*

Remarks *Thursa Mar 1<sup>st</sup> 1864*  
From past fresh breeze from the S E heading S W at 1 1/4 PM spoke the Fish Ferry the *Active* Capt. Blake 1700 tons once being the *Leahman* had a gam miauer & Lutter parts moderate up a up & an old Top Sail (Mafafuru in sight to the S E dist 35 miles)

Remarks *Wanusa Mar 2<sup>nd</sup>*

From past light air from the S E replaced an old Top Gallant Sail & bent it forward at 4 PM had a gam with *Anaconda* *Active* & *San Bern* miauer & Lutter parts calm took a light breeze at 11 AM breezed out the B Fish miauer two bbls

Remarks *Thursa Mar 3<sup>rd</sup>*

From past fine breeze from the S heading to the W at 4 AM looked to the E S E, the *Salcedo* in sight to the E. Miauer & Lutter parts very light air after breakfast 3 boats went in after wood

Remarks *Fria Mar 4<sup>th</sup>*

From past took a light air from the North steering along the *Sunda* it was dist 1 1/2 miles at 3 PM the boats got along near each one had a load of drift-wood cut it up & stowed it away steering to the S E the line E N E, one boat in sight getting wood miauer & Lutter parts moderate heading to the S E employed having the eyes of the rigging &c.

Remarks *Saturday Mar 5<sup>th</sup>*

From past moderate breeze from the Southward heading to the E employed having (miauer & Lutter parts the same)
