Remarks Tana Mar 6th 1864

Fore part fine breeze from S & E heading to the
E employed snapping & painting the Forework
Mizzen breezing on latter part strong breeze
In 7th 11th 7 Lat 37° 43' E

Remarks Mone Mar 7th
Fore part strong breeze from S & E heading to the
E unable to see the Top Sails Mizzen & latter
part a haze

Remarks Tana Mar 8th
Fore part a haze from the S heading to the
Eastward Mizzen & latter part moanating
employed repairing the M Sail

Remarks Wanausa Mar 9th
Fore part moanate breeze from the S heading
to the E employed repairing the M Sail
Mizzen & latter part light breeze from the
S & E heading to the Westward

Remarks Wanausa Mar 10th
Fore part light breeze & calm Mizzen & latter
part the same furnished the main sail &
but it washed the main Mast Tana the
Mizzen Rigging &c

Remarks Tana Mar 11th
Fore part light breeze & variable with some
rain Mizzen part the same latter part took
line light from the N steering S & E
employed snapping ship outside &c

Steering for Valcuhano
Remarks Tana Mar 12th 1864

Fore part light breeze from the N steering S & E
furnished snapping outside Mizzen & latter
part the wind very light hauling to the N & E

Remarks Tana Mar 13th
Fore part light air from the N steering to the E
saw land ahead dist 40 or 50 miles employed washing
Ship inside Mizzen & latter part foggy at
intervals the Tana in sight astern the Ship
heading N & W Lat 35° 42' S

Remarks Mone Mar 14th
Fore part light winds from the S heading
to the N with frequent fog squalls saw
a Ship & a Brig standing to the Eastward Mizzen
& latter part moanate with fog employed
mowing new Tanyana to the Bobstays & Bonnet
Rings & setting up

Remarks Tana Mar 15th
Fore part fine breeze from the S & W heading
to the S & E employed at ship's duty here it foggy
most of the time saw a number of ships & other
craft standing to the N & W Mizzen part strong
breeze looking to windward latter part light breeze
standing in for Cackine

Remarks Wanausa Mar 16th
Fore part light air from the S & W got inside
of the Bay at 2 P.M. came to Anchor at 4 P.M.
in 5 fathoms water the Capt went on shore
Mizzen & latter part moanate employed
cleaning the Chances guns &c got a greater
of Beef & some Onions from the shore
