

Back Mattias Seas of Dartmouth Capt Hobland
Remarks Since Mar 27th 1864

Fore part fine weather the wind ashore on liberty
middle part fine latter part had a rather fresh
rain & strong breeze the men came off from liberty

Remarks Since Mar 28th

Fore part rather with plenty of rain but still for
two men went ashore on liberty that stayed on
Coast yesterday got 100 Onions & 5 lbs of Beef
middle part cleared off the wind hauling to
the W latter part fine weather

Remarks Since Mar 29th

Fore part got off 2000 lbs of Bacon furnished
painting in the afternoon got two Ranz
of Black Spirit from the shore 20 lbs middle
& latter parts fine

Remarks Since Mar 30th

Fore part fine breeze from the E furnished Paint
Ship outside took on board 10 tons water furnished
setting up Shooks

Remarks Since 31st

Fore part fine took off the remainder of our water
from the Boat & tank making 20 ft tank in all
stowed down our water got off two Boat loads of
wood & stowed it away got two Barrels of Yellow Pine
boarding from the Henry Taber 30 ft of Oak
& 6 Cogge Poles

Remarks Since April 1st

Fore part fine painted the Chain round again
got off a lot of Potatoes Beans Onions Butter
Coffee &c after supper half the men went ashore
on liberty took the wind from the N latter
squally with rain

Laying at Talcahuano

Remarks Since April 2nd 1864

Fore part had a North with rain half the men on
liberty latter part fine the men came off the other
half went on liberty

Remarks Since April 3rd

Fore part fine weather part of the crew on liberty middle
& latter parts fine

Remarks Since April 4th

Fore part foggy at 7 AM the fog cleared off hove up
our Anchor & stowed outside the Ship & lit go
again the Ship all ready for sea came on shore
a Store & Pipe painted the Board round again
&c latter part light breeze from the South
7 men we shipped here came off including the Cook

Homeward Bound

Remarks Since April 5th

Fore part fine breeze from the South sent the
Boat in after the Capt the Ship ready for sea
at 12 N the Capt came off with a Cof of soap
for Topsail Braces & some other things

Remarks Since April 6th

Fore part fine weather good breeze from the
E fair wind took our Anchor & went to sea with
a compliment of 28 men & Boys all told fore &
aft stowed the Anchor & Cables & washed off Deck
paysia out by Larabena at 2 PM heading W
by E at 4 PM quite rugged fresh breeze took in the
light sails & a good ruffid the fore top sail heading
W by W chon watches middle & latter parts
fine & weather much the same
