

Back Matilda Seal of Dartmouth Capt Howland
Remarks Thursday April 28th 1864

Fore part fresh breeze from the Eastward heading from N, N E, to, N E, with cloudy weather at 10 P.M. taken to the light breeze at 2 A.M. taken back again latter part moderate with cloudy weather No Obs

Remarks Friday April 29th

Fore part moderate breeze from the Eastward heading from N E to N employees picking over Potatoes &c Mice part much the same taken to the light breeze latter part heading N E most of the time had some snow squalls
Long 53° 32' W Lat 37° 30' S

Remarks Saturday April 30th

Fore part fine breeze from the E, S E, steering N E by N by N brook out for water had some snow squalls Mice & latter parts the same No Obs

Remarks Sunday May 1st

Fore part light breeze from the Eastward with snow squalls steering N E by N by N had some Mice & latter parts continue moderate with cloudy weather No Obs

Remarks Monday May 2nd

Fore part light breeze from the S E steering N E by N by N saw some Porpoises at 5 P.M. Mice part the wind light & variable latter part took a breeze from the N by W
Long 49° 25' W Lat 48° 08' S

Bonnet to Gof's Island

Remarks Tuesday May 3rd 1864

Fore part a fresh breeze from the N by W heading to the N E got a pull on the back ropes & brought the employees overhauling the cutting blocks fitting a new strap to one of the lower blocks &c Mice part breezing on took in the light sails latter part the same doubled up the top sails & took in the fore & spanker at 12 N a Sea
Long 46° 49' W Lat 46° 41' S

Remarks Wednesday May 4th

Fore part a Gale from N N W commenced raining at 1 P.M. took in the M Sail heading N E at 4 P.M. took in the fore top sail & close up the main Mice part the wind heading to the Westward & moderating made sail steady N E latter part fine breeze under the bow boat
Long 44° 10' W Lat 43° 51' S

Remarks Thursday May 5th

Fore part fresh breeze from the N steering N E by N at 5 P.M. the wind heading more to the N by W Mice & latter parts strong breeze with foggy squalls No Obs

Remarks Friday May 6th

Fore part strong breeze from the N heading E N E with fog Mice part the wind heading more to the N E heading E at 7 A.M. bore ship to the N by W latter part had some rain took out for water took in the foreboard boat to repair No Obs

Remarks Saturday May 7th

Fore part fresh breeze from E, N E, heading N with rainy weather breezing on double up the top sails Mice part the wind heading to the N by W & moderating latter part moderate with thick fog heading N E No Obs
