

Bank Matuaa Chas of Dartmouth Capt Cowland
Remarks Tuna May 8th 1864

From part calm with thick foggy weather but hole
at 4 P.M. the fog let up & the sun came
out. Midday part took a light breeze from the N
heaving to the E. Latter part the wind became more
E. took ship to the N N W the fog lifted at 11
Lat 42° 09' S

Remarks Mone May 9th

From part fresh breeze from the N E, heaving
N, N W with thick foggy weather at 7 P.M. at 10
to rain here in squalls at 3 A.M. the wind
heaved out to the W & blowed a gully came for
3 or 4 hours took in the M Top Sail at 12 N
mouanating Long 38° 44' W Lat 41° 10' S

Remarks Tuna May 10th

From part the sea continues mouanating
at 2 P.M. set the M Top Sail & from sail the
line N W steering E by N with a breeze
Midday part - mouanating. Latter part a
light breeze from the W with cloudy weather
Long 37° 17' W Lat 40° 54' S

Remarks Wane May 11th

From part fresh breeze from the W steering E by N
with cloudy weather employees getting the
Boats ready for painting commenced one
& it began to rain gave it - fitted a new
Cutting Block Shep & at 7 P.M. the wind
W W Midday & Latter parts strong breeze
at daylight saw a Bank steering N E

Long 35° 02' W Lat 40° 37' S

Bona to Goffs Island

Remarks Tuna May 12th 1864

From part strong breeze from N W steering E 1/2 S with
cloudy weather attempted to paint some of the Boats
the water flew so gave it up. Painted the 2 Boats
inside under the ceiling Midday & Latter
parts strong breeze with some rain squalls
Long 29° 24' W Lat 40° 38' S

Remarks Tuna May 13th

From part a breeze from N W steering E 1/2 S with squally
weather Midday & Latter parts the same
took in the Fore Top Sail
Long 25° 27' W Lat 40° 52' S

Remarks Tuna May 14th

From part a breeze from the N, N W steering
E with breezy weather Midday part mouanating
Latter part light breeze from the N N W
made sail work out for water & breeze
Long 23° 19' W Lat 40° 53' S

Remarks Tuna May 15th

From part a moderate breeze from the N, steering
E, but hold & had some rain squalls towards night
Midday part the wind heaving round to the W
breezing on with frequent rain squalls double up
Latter part a breeze from the S W
Long 20° 12' W Lat 40° 11' S

Remarks Mone May 16th

From part a breeze from the S W steering E 1/2 S
blowing here in squalls with rain thousands
of Birds round Midday & Latter parts the
same took out Bug & Fork
Long 16° 30' W Lat 39° 40' S
