Remarks Since May 27th 1864

Fore part strong Gale from the S by W steering N by W
with rugged weather Midace & latter parts the
same Long 22° 35' W Lat 30° 24' S

Remarks Since May 28th

Fore part a Gale from the S by W with heavy squalls
& rain steering N by W at 4 P.M. took in the main
Top Sheet Sail & double reefed the M Top Sail
Midace part mackereling macker sail again
had some heavy rain squalls in the morning after
that came off pleasant the wind S

Long 24° 10' W Lat 27° 27' S

Remarks Since May 29th

Fore part strong breeze from the S steering N by W
after 2 P.M. steering N started a bit of Surf &
Midace & latter parts moderate with fine
weather having the appearance of the Trade winds
Long 24° 48' W Lat 25° 20' S

Remarks Since May 30th

Fore part moderate breeze from the S E with fine
weather steering N Midace & latter parts
variable winds from S to N E

Long 25° 44' W Lat 23° 22' S

Remarks Since May 31st

Fore part moderate breeze from the Eastward
steering N after 2 P.M. steering N by E took out
for better air Apples Sugar & bit of Holes Midace
part squally with rain latter part fine put out
the Larboard & Mast Boats took in the S Boat
for repairs painted the M Key all &c

Long 25° 52' W Lat 21° 15' S

Bark to the Western Grounds

Remarks Since June 1st 1864

Fore part moderate breeze from E, S E, steering N by E
1/2 E with fine weather employed at Ship's duty
Midace & latter parts much the same
Long 26° 06' W Lat 18° 37' S

Remarks Since June 2nd

Fore part fine breeze from E, S E, steering N by E 1/2 E,
with some rain squalls employed with hauling &
fitting the rigging Midace & latter parts moderate
lost Hole in the morning

Long 26° 12' W Lat 16° 26' S

Remarks Since June 3rd

Fore part light breeze from E, S E, with some rain-
squalls employed making Rope for Rattlings
fitting new Brace Block straps &c put the S Boat
out on the waves Midace & latter parts fine
breeze Long 25° 47' W Lat 14° 19' S

Remarks Since June 4th

Fore part fine breeze at E, S E, steering N by E
1/2 E employed fitting rigging & painting the
Starboard Boat Midace & latter parts moderate

Long 26° 27' W Lat 12° 10' S

Remarks Since June 5th

Fore part light winds at E, S E, steering N, N E,
employed at the rigging lost Hole after 4
P.M. Midace & latter parts fine weather

Long 26° 18' W Lat 9° 58' S

Remarks Since June 6th

Fore part fine breeze from E, S E, steering N, N E,
Midace & latter parts the same took out for
better & a M Royal but it hurt it up & set it
and two Sails standing to the Westward

Long 26° 13' W Lat 7° 25' S
