

Bark Matilda Sears of Dartmouth Capt Howland

Remarks Thrusa June 16th 1864

For part quite a breeze from N & by N heading N by W by N passed six or eight ships standing to the S Eastward employing making out rigging & squaring the rigging on the rigging & Mian & Gutter parts fine weather

Long 26° 44' W Lat 9° 40' N

Remarks Thrusa June 17th

For part fine breeze from the N & by E heading N by W employees squaring up the rigging to the lower rigging & passed one ship standing to the S started a bbl of But & Pork Mian & Gutter parts fine employees saving the Fore & Mast rigging & setting it up

Long 28° 12' W Lat 11° 34' N

Remarks Satrusa June 18th

For part fine breeze at E, N & E, heading N employees at ships duty Mian & Gutter parts much the same saw one ship

Long 29° 32' W Lat 13° 34' N

Remarks Suna June 19th

For part the breeze hauling more to the N & heading up at 7 P.M. strong breeze at N, N & E, heading N by W, but still Mian & Gutter parts heading at 11 A.M. took in the Fore & Top gallant Sail saw a ship on the other tack

Long 31° 21' W Lat 15° 54' N

Remarks Mona June 20th

For part strong breeze but a reef in the Top Sails heading N by W the wind N & E Mian & Gutter parts the same

Long 33° 17' W Lat 18° 06' N

Bound to the Western Islands

Remarks Thrusa June 21st 1864

For part strong breeze at N & E heading N by W employees at ships duty Mian & Gutter parts. The same took out for a Red M. Gallant Sail & sent it took a cloth out of the other one & cut it off about a foot

Long 35° 11' W Lat 20° 19' N

Remarks Thrusa June 22nd

For part strong N & E breeze heading N by W finished the Top Gallant Sail & sent it forward the old one being used up for this world Mian & Gutter parts much the same

Long 36° 09' W Lat 22° 31' N

Remarks Thrusa June 23rd

For part fine breeze heading N by W with fine weather started the Blacksmith Shop but still Mian & Gutter parts the breeze rather moderating Long 37° 27' W Lat 24° 55' N

Remarks Thrusa June 24th

For part fine breeze from N & by E heading N by W employees at ships duty took out a bbl of Tea Mian & Gutter parts the same

Long 38° 42' W Lat 27° 11' N

Remarks Satrusa June 25th

For part fine breeze and some pumps breaking tackle & stood to the S a spell found out what they were tackled back again heave N one ship in sight employees Rattling down the Fore Rigging clean & finished the Fore look to the Windlass & Mian & Gutter parts fine two ships in sight

Long 40° 30' W Lat 28° 38' N
