Remarks Tuesday July 12th 1864

Fore part light breeze from the S.W. heading
N.W. employed painting the plank shears
He saw a school of Black Fish going to leeward
saw a Brig standing to the Southward. Midace
& Gutter parts moderate employed painting
Ship inside saw B Fish going to leeward
Long 40° 32' W Lat 37° 52' N

Remarks Wednesday July 13th

Fore part light breeze from the N.W. steering
N by E furnished painting inside at 5 PM
saw some squid & a ship standing to the E
Midace & Gutter parts continue after the same
sort
Long 40° 03' W Lat 38° 37' N

Remarks Thursday July 14th

Fore part light wind from the N.W. steering N.E.
employed painting ship inside & at 6 PM
sawing N.W. with cloudy weather Midace & Gutter
parts had some rain squalls
Long 40° 13' W Lat 39° 45' N

Remarks Friday July 15th

Fore part moderate breeze from N.W. heading
N.W. with cloudy weather but clear & at 6 PM
saw a sail 2 points on the weather. Bow
cheek he all night spoke her at 6 PM & in
the civilian of Province town Gutter
part strong breeze heading N

Long 40° 48' W Lat 40° 35' N

Cruising on the Western Ground
Remarks Saturday July 16th 1864

Fore part strong breeze with rain squalls from
N.W. heading N.W. double reefed the
Top Sails took in the E. side saw a schooner
Midace & Gutter parts the same at 9 AM
kept her off E Long 39° 37' W Lat 41° 36' N

Remarks Sunday July 17th

Fore part strong breeze from the N.W. steering
E saw a ship standing to the S.W. coast for
water. Bow took in the E. side at sundown shortened
the Midace & Gutter parts moderate picked
up a Bbl with some varnish in it
Long 38° 25' W Lat 42° 15' N

Remarks Monday July 18th

Fore part moderate breeze from the N.W. steering
S.E. at sundown shortened sail & reefed to
the wind Midace part the same Gutter
part the wind from the Western breeze
on double reefed the Top Sails heading to
the N.W. Long 38° 50' W Lat 41° 45' N

Remarks Tuesday July 19th

Fore part the gale increasing took in the
Jib & Spanker Main Sail Fore Top Sail &
close reefed the Main at 7 PM
heading N.W. Midace the gale increasing
took in the Fore Sail turned up the
Bow & Waist Boats Gutter part moderate
heading to the S.W. saw a ship to windward
