

Barke Nicholas Vess of Dartmouth Capt. Constant
Remarks Thrusa July 28th 1864

Fore part fresh breeze from the W with some rain
squalls steering S.E. by E, saw two Brigs but holes
the Micae & latter part strong breeze at 10 AM
saw Flores bearing S.E. by E
Long 30° 13' 2" W Lat 39° 15' N

Remarks Wanaia July 29th

Fore part strong breeze from the W S W, steering
S.E. saw some Compositae Micae part fine breeze
at daylight Fayal 1 point on the lee board bearing
S.E. by E at 9 AM the Capt. went ashore at 10 arrived
off the town with the ship

Remarks Saluda July 30th

Fore part fine breeze the ship laying off & on at 6 1/2
PM the Capt. came off when we were forward
standing to the W the breeze from the E
the Boat brought off a few onions Micae & latter
part moderate steering to the N W at daylight
Fayal in sight a shore and plenty of Compositae
Long 29° 34' W Lat 38° 45' N

Remarks Luna July 31st

Fore part fine breeze from W, S W steering N.W. by N
at 2 PM luffa on the wind heading N.W.
saw a sail standing to the S.E. but told & C
Micae part the same latter part light-
breeze Flores & Corvo in sight to the N

Remarks Mona July Aug 1st

Fore part light breeze & calms one bark in
sight with the above Islands Micae part
light breeze & calms at daylight Flores
two miles off due to windward took a breeze
at 8 AM at 10 got in harbor to Santa Cruz
and away calm the Capt. went ashore

Cruising on the Western Ground

Remarks Thrusa Aug 2nd

Fore part light breeze from the N.W. sent in a raft
of casks 80 bbls with two of our Boats & two from
the shore at 4 1/2 PM took it along side stowed
it away took off 12 or 15 bushels Potatoes & a few
onions at 6 1/2 PM the Capt. came off sent ashore
one bbl of Flour some vinegar molasses Paint
Paint Brush a bbl of Black Fish oil & some other
small things including fifty lbs of Bread
at 6 1/2 PM square the yards steering S
Micae part light breeze latter part fine breeze
Long 30° 56' W Lat 38° 50' N

Remarks Wanaia Aug 3rd

Fore part strong breeze from the N.W. heading
N.W. by E at 5 PM luffa to the S.W. Flores in
sight to the N.E. dist 30 miles Micae part squally
with rain latter part moderate
Long 31° 20' W Lat 39° 17' N

Remarks Thrusa Aug 4th

Fore part moderate breeze from the N.W. heading
N.W. by E, Flores in sight at 7 PM sent 50 Casks to
S.E. dist 20 miles one sail in sight to windward
Micae part looking to windward at daylight
Corvo bearing S.E. latter part the wind from the
N heading to the N.W. ward
Long 31° 30' W Lat 39° 40' N

Remarks Luna Aug 5th

Fore part moderate breeze from the N.W. heading
N.W. by N, saw plenty of Compositae but many
whale Micae & latter part much the same
