

Backs Mathea Seas of Dartmouth Capt Howland
Remarks TUESDAY Aug 16th 1864

Fore part strong breeze from the NNE heading
NE by N with muggy weather saw two or three
muskatmen standing to the E middle
& latter parts squally with rain at 11 AM came off
Long 33° 07' W Lat 43° 37' N

Remarks WEDNESDAY Aug 17th

Fore part light breeze from the NNE heading to the
W at 3 PM breeze up a little middle & latter
parts fine breeze at 6 AM backed to the NE
Long 33° 45' W Lat 43° 37' N

Remarks THURSDAY Aug 18th

Fore part fine breeze from NNE heading NE by E
hook out for water but hold & struck a buoy & lost
him middle part calm latter part took a breeze
from the NNE heading to the NE
Long 34° 16' W Lat 43° 40' N

Remarks FRIDAY Aug 19th

Fore part strong breeze from the Westward backing
on double reefed the Top Sails had plenty of rain
from 1/2 to 3 PM when it cleared off at 5 PM
heading NE by E, middle & latter parts moderate
Long 34° 30' W Lat 43° 25' N

Remarks SATURDAY Aug 20th

Fore part light variable winds & calms had some thunder
squalls at a distance saw a very little of the
ship at 7 AM moderate breeze from the W heading
NNE caught three dolphins middle part the
same latter part strong breeze from the E heading
to the NNE took ship at noon

Long 35° 30' W Lat 43° 53' N

Cruising on the Western ground

Remarks SUNDAY Aug 21st 1864

Fore part came on with heavy squalls from the
E heading SE above reefed but hold took out
copied a pipe of oil that was leaking between
decks but took in the Fore Sail & Top Sail
down reefed the main middle & latter parts
a breeze with rain squally

Remarks MONDAY Aug 22nd

Fore part strong breeze with rain squally from the NNE
heading to the SE middle part moderating some
latter part steering to the W saw a whale to leeward
Long Lat 42° 57' N

Remarks TUESDAY Aug 23rd

Fore part the breeze from the NNE steering W with rain
squally under double reefed Top Sails middle &
latter parts a breeze from the NNE heading to
to the NNE Long Lat 42° 26' N

Remarks WEDNESDAY Aug 24th

Fore part the breeze continues from the NNE
heading to the NNE with frequent rain squalls
middle & latter parts the same
Long 37° 37' W Lat 42° 28' N

Remarks THURSDAY Aug 25th

Fore part squally weather with rain the breeze
heading to the NNE but hold & middle & latter
parts moderate breeze all sail heading to the NNE
Long 38° 19' W Lat 42° 00' N
