

Back Native Seal of Jacksonmouth Howland
Remarks Monae Sept 12th 1864

Fore part light breeze & variable calms from
nowhere in particular at sundown shortened
Fair cloudy weather midday & latter part
had some rain squalls saw two Whales spoke
the A K Tucker Capt Aikin 133 000

Long 39° 19' W Lat 40° 24' N

Remarks Tuesa Sept 13th

Fore part moderate run off & spoke the Gov
Larue of Westport Capt Chas 4 mo out clear
saw a large Steamer standing to the S & E
midday part rain squalls latter part strong
N, N E, the breeze from the S W

Long 38° 59' W Lat 41° 08' N

Remarks Wednesa Sept 14th

Fore part moderate fine weather standing
to the N, N E, at 4 P M came too & had
a gun with the George of N Bedford Capt
Wenton & the Gov Larue two other whalers
passed to leeward at 5 1/2 P M midday
part moderate latter part fresh breeze standing
to the S Long 39° 03' W Lat 40° 59' N

Remarks Thursa Sept 15th

Fore part strong breeze from the W standing
to the N, N W, hugging on double reef
took in 5th & 6th sail at sundown took
in the 7th sail fore sail & close reefed
the main and 6th whaler & two merchantmen
saw midday part the same latter part
moderating

Long 38° 58' W Lat 41° 31' N

Cruising on the western ground
Remarks Friae Sept 16th 1864

Fore part moderate breeze from the N, N E
with muggy weather saw a number of ships
& a school of Black Fish but Hole midday part
the same latter part calm employed
repairing a gib brock out an old one & appraised
it up to repair the other

Long 39° 17' W Lat 41° 40' N

Remarks Saturae Sept 17th

Fore part took a light breeze from the W & W
hudding to the S finished the gib & bent
it two ships in sight at sundown shortened
Fair midday & latter part fine breeze
standing N latter part S

Long 39° 07' W Lat 41° 45' N

Remarks Sunae Sept 18th

Fore part fresh breeze from the W hudding
to the N W spoke the Congress of N Bedford
Capt Castino 3 1/2 mo out 30 000 had a gun
midday part the same latter part strong and
refree Top sail breeze

Remarks Monae Sept 19th

Fore part strong breeze from the W hudding
to the Southwester midday part moderating
latter part calm tacked down some

Long 39° 13' W Lat 42° 20' N

Remarks Tuesa Sept 20th

Fore part light breeze from the N standing
S W fitted a new mast to the Fore Mast
& midday part moderate standing S E
latter part the same

Long 39° 12' W Lat 41° 40' N
