

Back Notice of Dartmouth - Howland
Remarks June Oct 16th 1864

For part strong breeze from the N E heading to the N N W at 11^h AM spoke the Oliver Cooker Lapham Boiling 6 and out 4.80 Spinn midea part moderate at 6^h AM midea Spinn Whales 4 points on the weather bow 4 miles off the Oliver was on our weather beam about 4^h miles off at 9 AM lowered away her boats went on & struck when the whales bent to lower their boats out since and they bent on & airted several times finally the struck again & got stove the line from the N the Whales going & the large boy of low & calves
Long 41^h 47 W Lat 39^h 25 N

Remarks Morn Oct 17th

For part strong breeze from the N with the boats off chasing the whales the waist boat bent on struck & airted bent on again & struck & the line part the foreboat bent on struck & turned up a two other whales that bent off spouting thick blood got the whale long side at 5 PM the waist & bow boats chasing the school off at sundown gave them up took in sail & three boats crew midea & Jettie part fine calla all hands at daylight hooked on to the got him in at 7 AM midea sail heading to the Westward Long 42^h 01 W Lat 38^h 49 N

Remarks June Oct 18th

For part a moderate breeze from the N with the employees backing out for water let Hodge & Washburn off at 3 PM spoke the Oliver had a gun midea part fine Jettie part a fresh breeze from the S W, minding N by W started the work

Cruising on the Western Ground

Remarks Morn Oct 19th 1864

For part strong breeze from the N W minding N N W finnish Boiling at 4 PM the whale made about 8 PM at dark close up the top sail starting N having the appearance of a Gale midea & Jettie part a Gale with Thunder lightning & rain
Long 42^h 15 W Lat 40^h 50 N

Remarks June Oct 20th

For part a Gale from the N W heading to the N N E at 6 PM rather more moderate and big standing to the E midea & Jettie part rainy employees washing ship at daylight took a breeze from the E minding N N W

Long 42^h 54 W Lat 41^h 25 N

Remarks June Oct 21st

For part a fine breeze from the Eastward minding N N W with rainy weather midea & Jettie part equally with rain the wind hauling to the N put some patches on a top sail & some new whipping on the points

Long 43^h 04 W Lat 42^h 12 N

Remarks June Oct 22nd

For part breezing on went the Ole Foretop sail & bent the one we repaired at 3 PM came on to blow & rain hard close up the top sail at sundown heading N the line N N W, midea part blowing heavy turned the sea boats stove the bow & waist boats after they were turned up Jettie part the same
