Remarks June Oct 23rd 1864

Fore part a heavy Gale from the N W heading
W, S W with rain squalls Midace & Jatta
part the Gale continuing about the same
Long 45th 44 W Lat 41st 25 N

Remarks Monce Oct 24th

Fore part the wind hauling a little more
to the W & moderating some at the
Fore sail at 5th P M the ship heading N
& made some sail the weather clearing &
unsettled nearly calm Midace part took a
breeze from the Southward steering W S W
Jatta part heaving split the main sail
To fix & hoist top sail sent down the main sail
& about a new one blowing strong with a heavy
sea

Remarks Tues Oct 25th

Fore part a Gale from the W S W heading
to the N W but a new craft sail & top sail
at 5th P M took in the Fore top sail & top sail
close reefed. The M S sail Midace part the
same Jatta part moderating but a new
Fore sail

Remarks Wednes Oct 26th

Fore part the wind from the N heading
to the Westward employees stowing away
between decks started a pipe of Brandy but a
new six bot Hold took in the Bow Boat &
put her over board & at 6 P M light air
from the N E Midace part fine breeze from
the S E steering W S W Jatta part the wind
S with rain

Homeward Bound

Remarks Thurs Oct 27th 1864

Fore part strong breeze from the Southward with
thick rainy weather steering W, S W killed
& Hoag at 5 P M the wind hauled to the S W
& started raining midace part squally with thunder
& lightning at 6th P M the wind hauled round
to the N S breeze & commenced to blow by 8
P M had in way thing except for top mast stay
sail & main spinnaker

Remarks Fri Oct 28th

Fore part the Gale continuing its fury over the
old Waist Boat all to pieces after supper unhooked
the Tacks & let her roll overboard for fear she
would give way at one end wing under the
Foreboard Boat & stave her the ship heading
from W to W, S W Midace part moderating
Jatta part the wind from the S W heading, to the
N W employees painting the Sails &c

Remarks Sat Oct 29th

Fore part fresh breeze from S W steering, N W W
nowice down on last few of Ore took out water
& the Carpenter employees repairing the decks
Midace part heaving on took in way thing except
close reefed M S sail & fore top mast stay sail Fore stay
sail & M Spencer the line S W steering W, S W
passed steamer in the night
Long 55th 30 W Lat 42nd 37 N

Remarks Sun Oct 30th

Fore part strong breeze from the W S W heading
to the N W took in top sail said & amole reefed
the Top sail Midace part moderating Jatta
part light air from the Westward heading
to the S & W
