August 7th 1850 At half past 7 Am. Sea acc. weighed Anchor and put to Sea light winds from N. to N.E. latter part light winds and Calms so ends heading out of the Bay in Co. with the George Washington, Hauser, and a bark

Thursday August 8th Commences with Light Winds from the Eastward Steering out of the Bay at 5 P.M. Discharge the Pilot the Light Boat of the Lion and Reg bearing S.E. by E. 10 mi. Dis. Middle part light winds from the Southward attended with Thunder Steering on Diff. Courses to the Southward from S.E. W. to S. latter part fresh breezes from S.E. at Mer-dean Lat. by Obs. 40° 08' N. Long. by Chro. 70° 24' W.

Friday Aug. 9th Commences with fresh breezes from S.E. Steering S.E. by S. at 6 P.M. Single reefed the Topsails at 10 Do. moderate latter part winds from S.E. to E. Steering on Diff. Co. all Sail set Employed in fitting Boats & Whale Craft Lat. by Obs. 38° 37' N. Long. by Chro. 69° 10' W.

Saturday August 10th. Comm. with light Winds from the W. and Calms Middle and latter part Strong winds from S.W. to W. Steering on Diff. Courses to the Eastward from S.E. to E.S.E. so ends equally took in the Main Topgallant sail and set it again. Lat. by Obs. 38° 01' N. Long. by Chro. 66° 40' W.

Sunday Aug. 11th. First part fresh breezes from W. S.W. Steering S.E. by E. at 7 P.M. Double reefed the Topsails, Middle part very equally attended with Thunder and rain part of the time under a close reefed Main Topsail latter winds from W. to S.W. and equally all Sail set so ends Lat. by Obs. 36° 58' N. Long. by Chro. 64° 16' W.

Monday Aug. 12th. Strong Winds from S.W. to to S. and Overcast Steering E.S.E. all Sail set Lat. by Obs. 35° 43' N. Long. by Chro. 61° 32' W.

Tuesday August 13th. Commences with moderate Winds S.W. W. Steering E.S.E. Middle part Calm, latter part light Winds from S.E. to S. Steering on Diff. tacks

Lat. by Obs. 35° 26' N. Long. by Chro. 60° 52' W.
Wednesday August 14th. Light winds from E.S.E. to S. Steering on Different Courses to the Eastward Lat. by Obs. 35° 48' N. Long. by Chro. 59° 10' W.

Thursday Aug. 15th First part moderate winds from S. Middle and latter part Strong winds and equally Steering E. & E. by S under all Sail Lat. by Obs. 35° 55' N. Long. by Chro. 56° 12' W.

Friday Aug. 16th. Strong Winds S.S.W. Steering E. at 6 P.M. Single reefed the Topsails and set Top Gallant sails over latter part the same Lat. by Obs. 36° 09' N. Long. by Chro. 52° 44' W.

Saturday August 17th. Strong winds from the Southward Steering to the Eastward by the wind under all Sail Lat. by Obs. 36° 37' N. Long. by Chro. 49° 23' W.

Sunday Aug. 18th fresh breezes from the Southward and equally Steering to the Eastward by the wind Middle and latter part under Double reefs Lat. by Obs. 37° 14' N. Long. by Chro. 47° 08' W.

Monday Aug. 19th. Strong Gales from S.S.E. at 7 P.M. under a double reefed Main Topsail & Fore Sail heading to the E. at 7 Am. wore Ship so ends Lat. by Obs. 37° 16' N. Long. by Chro. 46° 55' W.

Tuesday Aug. 20th Strong winds from S.S.E. heading to the S.W. under easy Sail at 1/2 past 5 Am. saw Sp. Whales in the Ships wake lowered the Boats and returned again to the Ship without success at 10 Do. lowered again at noon took one whale to the Ship Lat. by Obs. 36° 15' N. Long. 47° 30' W.
