breezes Lat. by obs. 13-56 S. Long. by Chro. 157-56 W.

Saturday Dec. 11th. 1st part moderate Winds from
S. E. and fair at 10 P.M. had a squall and sprung
the fore topmast badly latter part fresh breezes
from S. sent down the fore topmast ship under
short sail Steering to the Southward by the wind

Pigs &c. at 7 P.M. all on board and Steered to the westward
until clear of the Island and then Steered to the S. E. by the
wind, winds from S. E. to S. W. Lat. by obs. 22-30 S.
Long. by Chro. 159-16 W.
