Monday Dec 28th

First part moderate breeze from S.W. ship steering course S.E. under all sail at 1 P.M. the wind hauled to the N.W. with fine weather middle and latter part the wind from N.W. with fine weather and two sails steering to the Eastward Lat 54° 28' Long 76° 04' E

Tuesday Dec 29th

First part moderate breeze from N.W. with fine weather ship steering course S.E. under all sail at 2 P.M. hauled to S.E. middle part fresh breeze and squally at day light kept East latter part moderate breeze and fine weather and two sails steering the Eastward and one steering to the west

Wednesday Dec 30th

Commenced with moderate breeze from N.W. with fair weather ship steering S.E. N.E. under all sail middle and latter part variable winds with squally ship working to the Eastward at 3 P.M. sighted the Diegoz Rocks bearing N.E. by N. 13 miles distant and two vessels, some steering to the Eastward and others to the westward no Obs.

Thursday Dec 31st

First part variable winds with rain squalls ship working to the Eastward middle and latter part calm with rain squally and two sails no Obs.
