Thursday Jan 7th

First part fresh breeze
from S.E. with cloudy weather ship steering
course N.N.E. under all sail at 3 P.M. heaved
N. by W. at 6 do. sight the East side of the
Falkland Islands bearing West middle
and latter part moderate breeze from S.E. ship
steering N.N.W. Lat 30° 47' S.

Friday Jan 8th

First part moderate breeze from
S.E. with cloudy weather ship steering course
N.N.W. under all sail middle part light air
latter part calm Lat 49° 36' S.

Long 53° 46' W

Saturday Jan 9th

Commences with calm
at 2 P.M. took a breeze from N. ship heading
to the Eastward by the wind at 7 do. wore then
to the Westward middle and latter part
strong winds took in the light sails and
double reefed the topsails at midnight
wore ship to the Eastward

Lat 49° 01' S
Long 58° 22' W

North in the South Atlantic Ocean 1869
Sunday Jan 10th

First part strong winds from
N.W. with clear weather ship by the wind
heading to the N.E. under topsails middle and
latter part the same weather the wind from
Westward ship heading to the north

Monday Jan 11th

First part fresh breeze from
North ship on opposite tack, middle and
latter part more moderate with the wind
from N.W. with clear weather employed
in repairing the rig Lat 46° 24' S.

Tuesday Jan 12th

First part light airs from W.
S.W. with fine weather ship by the wind
heading to the N.N.W. under all sail
middle part wind from N.W. latter part
the wind from West fresh took in the
main gallant sail saw a ship steering
to the South
