First part fresh breeze from W. S. W. with clear weather. Ship by the wind heading to the north and with middle topsails middle and latter part light breeze from W. to N. W. ship heading to the north under all sail

Thursday Jan 14th

First part light breeze from N. W. W. with fine weather. Ship by the wind heading to the north middle part the wind from S. E. latter part wind from East ship steering N. W. saw four sails steering to the southward

Lat. 42° 04' S.

Friday Jan 15th

First part fresh breeze from East with pleasant weather ship steering North at sunset took in sail and luffed to middle and latter part the wind from N. with rainy weather ship hove to heading to the N. W. no Ob.

Saturday Jan 16th

Commenced with the wind from the north with thick weather at 1 P. M. wore ship to the Eastward at 4.30 the wind shifted to the west with clear weather at 5.30 blowing fresh gale ship hove to under double reef main topsail middle part more moderate latter part the wind hauled to the South at 6.30 kept on off course north and under sail

Sunday Jan 17th

First part light breeze from South with hazy weather ship steering course N. by E. under easy sail middle part wind from East latter part the wind hauled to the North ship by the wind on opposite tack under all sail
