Monday Jan 18th

Commences with the moderate breeze from N. with varying weather ship by the wind on opposite tack under all sail. Middle part the wind hauled to the S. W. with clear weather. Steered course N. N. E. under easy sail. latter light gale and rugged.

Long 53° 18' W

Tuesday Jan 19th

Commences with light gale from S. W. with clear weather ship steering course N. N. E. under easy sail at sundown more moderate. Middle and latter part the wind from N. W. ship steering different courses and a number of vessels, steering to the Eastward.

Long 51° 30' W

Wednesday Jan 20th

First part fresh breeze from N. W. with clear weather ship by the wind heading to the north at sundown wore ship to the Southward middle and latter part moderate breeze from S. W. ship on different tacks, Lat five

Lat. 35° 35' S
Long 52° 05' W

Thursday Jan 21st

First part fresh breeze from S. W. with clear weather ship by the wind on different tacks at sundown took in sail middle and latter part the same at 9 A. M. steered N. E. laid one sail steered to the south, hauled out, the chains and cleared them and got them ready to clear.
