Commenced with light breeze from South with fine weather ship steering N.E. at sundown took astern breeze from the same quarter at 10 took in sail and luffed to heading to the Eastward middle and latter part the wind from S.E. ship heading to the N.E. under easy sail saw three sails steering to the South

Monday Jan 25th

First part fresh breeze from S.E. with cloudy weather ship by the wind head to the N.E. middle and latter part the wind the same and rugged ship by the wind heading to the N.E. crew employed in ship duty saw one sail
