Wednesday Feb 24<sup>th</sup>

First part light breeze from East with pleasant weather ship steering N. by E. under all sail Middle part light air latter part light air and calm crew employed in working on the rigging and head sails

Lat. 18° 05' S  
Long 31° 15' W

Thursday Feb 25<sup>th</sup>

First part light breeze from N. E. with fine weather ship by the wind heading to the northward under all sail middle part the same latter part light air and calm employed in getting out water and running it in the tank and rattling down the lower rigging two sails in sight

Lat. 18° 31' S  
Long 31° 50' W

Steering to the North 1869

Friday Feb 26<sup>th</sup>

First part light air from East ship steering N. N. E. under all sail middle and latter part moderate breeze from E. N. E. with fine weather crew employed in ship duty and three vessels

Lat. 15° 41' S  
Long 32° 12' W

Saturday Feb 27<sup>th</sup>

First part moderate breeze from East with fine weather ship steering by the wind heading to the north under all sail middle and latter part good breeze crew employed in rattling down the lower rigging and doing other jobs about the ship Had two sails

Lat. 13° 05' S  
Long 32° 03' W
