First part light breeze from
East ship steering north under all sail
middle and latter part calm with
heavy swell employed in rattling down
washing ship out side to paint and took in
the fore foot and put it on the house
saw two sails

Wednesday March 3rd
First part calm middle
and latter part light air from South
ship steering north under all sail
crew employed in painting the bends and
sides and doing other jobs about the
ship saw three vessels
