Saturday March 6th

First part light breeze from
S. E. with fine weather ship steering
N. N. W. under all drawing sail
middle and latter part light breeze from
Southward crew employed in painting
ship out side

Lat 2° 09' S.
Long 35° 20' W

Sunday March 7th

First part light breeze from
South and calm with fine weather
ship working to the north middle and
latter part the same said three vessels
at midnight had a rain squall and
washed all the paint off the side of the
ship that was on green
