First part fresh breeze from N.E. with fine weather ship steering course N.W. by N. under all sail middle and latter part wind the same with heavy swell from north saw two humpbacks

Monday March 22nd

First part moderate breeze from N.E. with fine weather ship steering course N.W. by N. under all sail middle and latter part fresh breeze from N.E. to E. crew employed in painting saw two sails and small pieces of gulf weed

Steering to the north in the N. Atlantic

Tuesday March 23rd 1867

First part moderate breeze from N.E. with fine weather ship steering course N.W. by N. under all sail middle part the same latter part the wind from East crew employed in painting the mast and other paint work saw two sails

Wednesday March 24th

First part moderate breeze from East with fine weather ship steering N.W. by N. under all sail middle and latter part light breeze from East to South crew employed in painting spars and other paint work saw two sails steering to the South
