 pendant and took the craft out of the  
 boats and stowed it away and asail

First part fresh  
 breeze from S. W. with foggy weather ship  
 steering course N. N. W. under all sail

 sails at 5 o'clock the wind hauled to the  
 N. W. blowing light gale with squalls. at 10  
 double reefed the fore topsail at 11 o'clock took  
 in the jib and main sail and double  
 reefed the main topsail ship by the  
 wind heading to the north sails one sail
