Thursday August 26th

First part light breeze from S.W. with rain. Horn ship bore heading to the Northward under close reef of top sails. Middle and latter part more moderate with rain squalls at daylight made sail and steered North. Crew employed in ship's duty. Sailed two sails.

Friday Aug 27th

First part moderate breeze from S.W. with heavy swell. Weather clear. Ship steering N.W. at sundown were ship to the S.E. and took in last latter part strong breeze with foggy squalls at daylight steered S.E. by E. crew employed in ship's duty. Sailed two sails.

Saturday Aug 28th

First part fresh breeze from N.W. with muggy weather. Ship steering S. by E. under easy sail. Middle and latter part more moderate at daylight made sail and steered East. Crew employed in getting for top sail light. Sailed as usual.

Sunday Aug 29th

First part moderate breeze from north with cloudy weather. Ship steering East. At sundown took in sail and heaved to the wind heading to the Eastward. Middle part the same. Latter part calm.

Monday Aug 30th

Commenced with calm at 1 P.M. took a light breeze from North. Ship by the wind heading to the East at dark took in the light sails. Middle and latter part light breeze from S.E. with heavy weather. Ship heading to the Eastward at daylight made sail. Crew employed in getting the main top sail and galliot light.

First part light breeze from S.W. with fine weather. Ship by the wind heading to the S.E. under easy sail. Middle and latter part the same. Crew employed in ship's duty. Sailed the sails steering to the Eastward.

First part moderate breeze from S.W. with cloudy weather. Ship by the wind heading to the Southward under all sail. At dark took in the light sails. Middle part wind from West. Latter part wind from N.W. with foggy squalls. Ship steering S.W. crew employed in ship's duty. Sailed two sails.

Saturday Sept 4th

First part fresh breeze from north with clear weather. Ship steering S.W. by W. under top sails and main gallant. Middle and latter part moderate breeze from N.W. at 11 A.M. sighted the Islands of Cook and Flores bearing S.E. crew employed in ship's duty. Sailed two sails.
