

Back. Matilda Seas

Monday January 31st Fine part calm with clear weather. Middle part the same latter part light breeze from S.E. ship on opposite tack, lat. midship North Cape for S.M. 10 miles and

Tuesday February 1st Fine part light air and calm ship heading to the Southward Middle and latter part light variable wind ship to the wind working to the S.E. at 8 A.M. raised black fish lowered and got two at midship knuckle found for S.M. 25 miles and

Wednesday Feb 2nd Fine part calm with cloudy weather Middle part fresh breeze from Eastward with clear weather ship to the wind heading to the S.E. at daylight showed in doubtless Bay latter part light breeze from the S.E. ship beating up the Bay at 10 A.M. came to anchor in the outer harbor at Monganui in 10 fathom water crew employed in building out the black fish and put the old board over board for shore boat

Thursday Feb 3rd This day we have strong wind from S.E. ship laying waiting for a chance to get in the inner harbor crew employed in odd jobs about the ship

Friday Feb 4th Fresh breeze from the East with cloudy weather ship laying in the outer harbor waiting for a chance to get in the inner harbor

Saturday February 5th Fresh breeze from East at 6 A.M. got uneasy and came into the inner harbor and came to anchor at 10 A.M. put up the tackle and broke out all the shuck, out of the fore peak

Sunday Feb 6th Strong breeze from East with pleasant weather

Monday Feb 7th Strong East winds with clear weather crew employed in breaking out in the fore hold and pumping out the fresh water out of the ground tier and filling it with salt water and landing shokes and shuck head casks discharged and landed 30 packages No 1 to 30.
