

Bark Matilda Sears

Thursday May 5th First part strong breeze from South with pleasant weather ship by the land heading to the west Middle and latter part wind from the North with cloudy weather at daylight said a bark got whale chased with gunn after the latter whale but got no chance at them at meridian Milford Haven bore S. by E. 30 miles dist and two sails

Friday May 6th First part moderate breeze from North with cloudy weather ship on opposite tack Spoke by Bark Swan Brothers at sundown took in sail Middle part calm latter part light air from north ship heading to the Eastward Dred two sails at meridian Milford Haven bore S. by E. 40 miles dist

Saturday May 7th First part calm and light air at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part the same at meridian Milford Haven bore East 40 miles dist and two sails

Sunday May 8th First part light air and calm with cloudy weather at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part moderate breeze from South with cloudy weather at daylight Steered off to the north said one sail at meridian Milford Haven bore S. by E. 30 miles dist

Cruising Off Milford Haven 19.30

Monday May 9th First part moderate breeze from South with rainy weather ship heading off to the north at dark took sail and shifted to the wind Middle part the same latter part strong wind from South with clear weather at 3 P.M. On run off to the north at 11 A.M. shifted to the wind heading to the west at meridian Cascade point bore East 30 miles dist

Tuesday May 10th First part strong wind from South with clear weather and rugged ship by the wind on opposite tack under easy sail Middle and latter part moderate breeze from the westward ship on opposite tack under easy sail at meridian Cascade point bore E. 30 miles dist

Wednesday May 11th Commenced with moderate breeze from the west ward with pleasant weather ship by the wind on opposite tack under easy sail at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part wind the same with fog squalls said two sails at meridian Milford Haven bore S. by E. 20 miles dist

Thursday May 12th First part light baffling wind with fog squalls ship by the wind heading off shore at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part the same said two sails at meridian Milford Haven bore S. by E. 30 miles dist Crew employed in getting provisions and doing other jobs about the ship
