 with moderate breeze from S.E. with
 thick rainy weather. Ship by the wind heading
 to the South at dark took in sail
 Middle part calm later part strong breeze
 from South with cloudy weather Ship by the
 wind heading in. One under close reef
 topsails said the land
 Looked S.W. 1/4 S.

Sunday May 22nd First part. Strong breeze
 from South with cloudy weather Ship heading
 to the East at 4 P.M. took in the fore topsail
 and close reefed the main topsail.
 Middle part wind from S.W. with foggy squalls
 latter part wind from West at daylight Steered off
 N.N.W. under easy sail at 10 A.M. luffed to the
 wind heading to the North said on sail and the
 land

Monday May 23rd At midnight the wind
 hauled to the South blowing a gale with heavy squalls
 took in fore sail and fore topsail and close reefed
 the main topsail. Middle and latter part more
 moderate at 10 A.M. more ship to the East said
 sail
 no Obs.

Tuesday May 24th Strong wind from S.W.
 with squally weather. Ship heading to the East under
 easy sail at 8 P.M. luffed to the wind heading to
 the South Middle and latter part light gale
 from West with rainy squally weather Ship bore
 heading to the Southward at midnight said the land
 bearing to the S.E. 10 miles distant

Cruising off Milford Haven 1870

Wednesday May 25th First part light gale from
 West with rainy weather Ship bore to East P.M. wore
 Ship to the Northward Middle part fresh breeze
 latter part moderate breeze with clear weather said two
 sails and land at midnight Milford Haven bore
 S.E. 25 miles distant

Thursday May 26th First part light air from
 West with clear weather Ship steering different course
 under all sail at sundown took in sail
 Middle and latter part moderate breeze from North with
 cloudy weather Ship steering different courses Spoke the
 Barb. Three Brothers at midnight Milford Haven bore
 S.E. 25 miles distant

Friday May 27th First part moderate breeze from
 N.W. with cloudy weather Ship steering off to the South
 at sundown took in sail and luffed to heading to the
 West Middle and latter part wind from N.W.
 with hazy weather at daylight wore ship to the South
 said two sails
 no Obs.

Saturday May 28th First part strong variable
 winds with squally weather Ship by the wind
 heading to the Southward under easy sail Spoke
 the Barb. Cynthia at sundown took in sail
 Middle and latter part weather the same Ship on
 different tacks under double reef topsails said
 two sails
 no Obs.
