

Bark Matilda Sears.

Monday June 6th

Commences with fresh breeze from the north with squally weather ship heading to the west at 3 P.M. the wind hauled to the S.W. blowing light gale. Middle and latter part fresh breeze from S. with pleasant weather ship by the wind heading to the east under all sail land in sight at Meridian. Cape Horn S.E. 30 miles distant.

Tuesday June 7th

Commences with fresh breeze from the South with pleasant weather ship steering long with the land to the north at dark took in sail and heeled to the wind heading off shore. Middle and latter part light breeze from South at daylight. Steered long the land to the north at Meridian. Thompson Sound bore S.E. 10 miles distant. Sheaved board and put it out.

Wednesday June 8th

First part light breeze from South with pleasant weather ship steering to the north at sundown took in sail and heeled to heading off shore. Middle and latter part light air at daylight. Steered off to the north at Meridian. Thompson Sound bore S.E. 15 miles distant. Took out water out of the fore hold and put in the tank.

Thursday June 9th

First part light air and calm with cloudy weather ship steering to the north at dark took in sail. Middle and latter part thick rainy weather with the wind from the S.W. Sailed the land.

Cruising off Milford Haven.

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Friday June 10th

Commences with light air from South with thick rainy weather ship steering to the northward at sundown took in sail and heeled to the wind heading to the westward. Middle part weather the same latter part strong breeze from north with squally rainy weather ship by the wind heading to the westward about the land.

Saturday June 11th

Commences with strong breeze from North with rainy weather ship by the wind heading to the westward under easy sail at 2 P.M. the wind hauled to the west with cloudy weather. Middle part wind from the west. Latter part light gale from the north with thick weather. Sailed the land.

Sunday June 12th

First part light gale from the north with variable weather ship heading to the westward. Middle and latter part wind from north to Southeast with rainy weather ship bore to under short sail. Sailed the land. Bearing to the S.E. 10 miles distant.

Monday June 13th

First part fresh breeze from East with heavy cross sea and rainy weather ship heading to the north under short sail. Middle and latter part light gale from South with clear weather ship by the wind heading to the Eastward under close reef topsails. Land in sight at Meridian. Milford Haven bore S.E. 20 miles distant at 10 Steered E.N.E.
